Worship Notes

Thank you, TBC, for your hard work during this past week's Vacation Bible School! Our Director of Missions, Gary Goodin, was incredibly impressed with the level of volunteer support! I told him we have great folks here who absolutely love to serve. So, thank you!

And if you are here as a guest because your child came to our VBS this past week, we would love to get to know you! If you have any questions, feel free to see me after the service and introduce yourself. We're glad you're here!

Also, to any fathers in the congregation, we are especially thankful for you on this Father's Day! We are thankful that you are here with us! We also want to say thank you to the men who do not have children but have been spiritual fathers to others. Your spiritual service to the Lord is so vital and appreciated, also!

This morning's service will center around the theme of access from Romans 5:1-11 with a special connection to Father's Day as we consider that we have access with God our Father by grace through faith!

Our first song reminds us of God's Fatherly care in that, with His Son Jesus, He has a place waiting for those of us who know Him ("**Jerusalem**"). God's Fatherly kindness is shown to us in that "the earth is filled with His glory" ("**Holy Is the Lord**"). The Lord has revealed something about Himself even in creation (Romans 1:20), which declares His glory. God's Fatherly goodness is seen in "**Good, Good Father**" as we acknowledge in song that we're "never alone" and that he knows "just what we need before we say a word."

"**It Is Well**" combines the idea of access to God with the reality of God's Fatherly mercy. This newer version of the old hymn has added the line, "Through the storm I am held." God is a merciful Father who loves His children by walking through the valleys with us (Psalm 23:4). And we should be encouraged that, just as Jesus Christ is our "**Living Hope**," so is God the Father alive and ruling right now! His care and concern for His children will last as long as He does, and our God is eternal!

Finally, we'll end with a hymn of encouragement, "**This Is My Father's World**." One of my favorite lines in any hymn is the final verse. Consider it and be encouraged: "This is my Father's world, / O let me ne'er forget / That though the wrong seems oft so strong, / God is the Ruler yet. / This is my Father's world, / The battle is not done; / Jesus, who died, shall be satisfied, / And earth and heav'n be one."

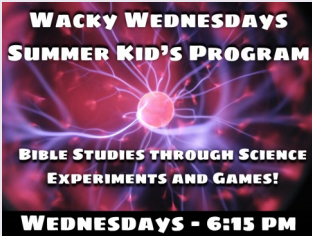
