DAY 1

- **Scripture:** Romans 14:5-6
- **Discussion:** Our Easter devotional, Love to the Uttermost, mentions that many Christians have found Holy Week (Palm Sunday-Easter) a meaningful time. How does Romans 14:5-6 relate to this? How we make sure this week is centered more on Christ than tradition? And how are we to treat those who don't necessarily observe Holy Week/Easter?

DAY 2

- **Scripture:** John 13:1, Philippians 2:1-11
- **Discussion:** In Love to the Uttermost, emphasis is placed on the word *uttermost*. Consider some ways this word captures the sacrifice of Christ on the cross as our substitute, especially focusing on the Philippians passage above.

- **Scripture:** John 10:1-18
- **Discussion:** What lessons do we learn about Christ's death and resurrection from this passage? How is this different from the behavior of a typical shepherd with regard to his sheep?
