Worship Notes

"This is the day that the Lord has made; let us rejoice and be glad in it" (Psalm 118:24, ESV). We have much for which to rejoice, and that is why we have gathered today--to rejoice and be glad in and on this Lord's Day!

We have the honor of having two guests with us this morning. The first is Thomas Johnson, son of Chris & Lisa Johnson (our sound tech. & pianist, respectively). Thomas is currently attending New Orleans Baptist Theological Seminary and, as of the time of this writing, is currently experiencing flooding and trying to figure out how to arrive in Macon this weekend.

Our other guest is the candidate for interim pastor, Dr. Tom Rush. He is the founder of TREAD (Tom Rush Evangelism & Discipleship) Ministries, and is a sought-after speaker for revivals, conferences, and evangelism training events. He is a gifted evangelist with a wealth of experience from pastoring multiple churches. We know that you will be blessed by hearing him preach today. After he preaches, all church members are invited to vote on whether to issue the official invitation to Bro. Tom to serve as our interim pastor during this time of transition in the life of our church.

Even in light of the importance of voting on an interim, the most important thing that will happen today is the worship of our Lord Jesus Christ! Once again, that's why we are here! Today, our service will focus specifically on the Lordship of Christ as well as the wonderful change in the believer's life that takes place at the moment of conversion (and beyond!) through the powerful working of God and His gospel.

We begin by proclaiming that God's "love endures forever" and that "He is above all things," pointing to the love of God in saving sinners as well as His mighty power (**"Forever"**). In **"Heaven Came Down,"** a song that Bro. Tom will reference in his message, we'll sing of the day when Christ changes believers, of which we can say "Heaven came down and glory filled my soul!" And as Christ exercises His Lordship over us, He does so as a great and compassionate High Priest (**"Before the Throne of God Above"**). The choir will sing **"Our God"** and re-emphasize that "Our God is greater" than any false "god" the world may proclaim!

Finally, we'll close our service by singing, **"All I Have Is Christ."** This song is a song of testimony: "I once was lost in darkest night, yet thought I knew the way. The sin that promised joy and life had let me to the grave...As I ran my hell-bound race, indifferent to the cost, You looked upon my helpless state and led me to the cross. And I beheld God's love displayed. You suffered in my place. You bore the wrath reserved for me. Now all I know is grace" And it is a song of praise: "Hallelujah! All I have is Christ. Hallelujah! Jesus is my life."
