# **Worship Notes**

Welcome to our service of worship on this Lord's Day! We are thankful you are here! This morning, we have the privilege of hearing from guest preacher, Dr. Tom Rush. He is an itinerant evangelist with TREAD (Tom Rush Evangelism and Discipleship) Ministries. He has a wealth of experience in pastoral ministry and evangelistic training. He has also served in both the U.S. Navy (in Surface Warfare and later as Chaplain) and U.S. Air Force (Chaplain). He has pastored churches in Georgia. North Carolina. Florida and New Mexico and has been in full-time vocational ministry for 34 years.


Today, on this Sunday before Independence Day, we open our service with a recognition of God's hand of providence as we sing our national hymn, "God of Our Fathers." This song reminds us of God's providential control of nature as well as the nation. The hymn also asks the Lord to "Refresh Thy people on their toilsome way. Lead us from night to never-ending day." As followers of Jesus Christ, it is the sharing of the gospel that is the only hope for the nation, and we pray that God would refresh, renew, and revive the Christians of this nation to share that glorious gospel message. The choir will follow this hymn by declaring the power of our Lord to rule and guide us in "You Are God Alone" and that He is on His throne.

We will also turn our attention to the gospel and be reminded of God's power to save men, women, boys and girls in our community. In "Jesus, Thank You" we proclaim that it is Jesus who brings us to God, for it is "By [His] perfect sacrifice [we've] been brought near" and that we who trust in Christ alone for salvation have full fellowship with God: "Once Your enemy now seated at Your table." "Cornerstone" follows that message with the reminder that it is "Christ alone, Cornerstone" that is the rock of our salvation ("my hope is built on nothing less than Jesus' blood and righteousness") and the rock of Christian living ("Through the storm. He is Lord. Lord of all." The solo. "When He Reached Down His Hand for Me" likewise shares the message that we were astray, wretched, vile, and sunk without God! He had to reach down His hand to save us.

Today's service ends with "O Great God," a song that relates the beauty of the gospel and its wonderful saving power in the lives of others. As we share the gospel, we must trust God to "conquer every rebel pow'r" and to open the eyes of those "blinded by [their] sin," knowing full well that the Spirit can give life and open the Word to them! We must be faithful to share the Good News, trusting in the Lord to act and do what only HE can do!
