Encouraged by family and friends, we are reaching out in hopes of you and your organization supporting our upcoming fundraising campaign period, by hosting a **Cannonballs for a Cure** event. In 2018, on May 17th, the inaugural **Cannonballs Across America** program was launched by the **Cannonballs for Kayne Foundation** and has already raised \$10,000.

Cannonballs for Kayne is an emerging national public charity, nonprofit entity raising funds in pursuit of a cure for pediatric brain cancer and DIPG (diffuse intrinsic pontine glioma) that serves as a resource and aids afflicted families.

A cross-country cycling journey with a goal of fundraising \$1M to battle DIPG! The focus during the campaign period while the guys are riding is to connect with families, swim teams, schools, organizations and churches to educate about brain tumors and bring people together for a common cause.

All proceeds from this beneficial program fund research into the deadliest form of childhood brain cancer: DIPG and help with other brain tumors. Researchers believe that by uncovering a cure to DIPG, the mystery will be unlocked for many other cancers that cause death. This makes your participation very meaningful for children and adults.

OUR INSPIRATION

Cannonballs for Kayne started with a hashtag on social media as a way for swimmers, friends and family to cheer up Kayne Finley, a Northern Kentucky native, Spruce Creek High School 2017 grad in the Daytona Beach area, and Louisiana State University student and team manager for the varsity swim team. Kayne, at 17 years old, was diagnosed with DIPG, the rare, inoperable brain cancer of the brainstem.

As a lifelong competitive swimmer, Kayne loved the water, and continued to enjoy the pool even after his DIPG diagnosis. DIPG roughly affects about 300 children, teens and adults in the United States each year, and is known as the leading cause of death from pediatric brain tumors, carrying a poor prognosis with near 0% chance of survival beyond two years and a median survival of just 9 months.

Kayne's profound outlook on life, strong faith, passion for improving the lives of children diagnosed with brain cancer, raising awareness, and fundraising for research has been carried on through the foundation he created shortly before his untimely death in November 2017. Personal prayers and donations for all children fighting this and other horrible diseases are also encouraged and appreciated.

HOW YOU MAKE A DIFFERENCE

Our Cannonballs Team needs your help in carrying out Kayne's mission to fight for a cure for children impacted by brain cancer. - 2. Designate when and where your participants will complete their "cannonballs".



Before the Event

Register Your Team

Organization Leaders/Team Captains, please follow these steps to register your team.

- 1. Visit CannonballsAcrossAmerica.org website for general program information and registration link..
- 2. Click the Registration button and familiarize yourself with the registration site which takes you to: https://runsignup.com/Race/CA/PaloAlto/CannonballsAcrossAmerica.
- 3. Click the yellow "Donate" button at the top of your screen.



- 4. Fill in the fields with your personal and team information.
- 5. Customize your personal message to display on your Team Fundraiser page
- 6. Set a fundraising goal. We suggest making an attainable, realistic goal. You can always increase it once the goal has been exceeded.
- Create your custom fundraiser URL so that your team's website
 will be easily accessible by participants and donors. This

- 8. You may elect additional Fundraiser Captains to help manage your fundraiser. Fundraiser Captains must first create their own RunSignUp account. You can allow others to help manage by entering their email in the "Fundraiser Captains" section.
- 9. Once your profile is complete, share your Team URL with participants. Direct them to Register for a virtual event and/or Donate under you team in order to track progress toward awards.

During the Event

Choose Your Activity

OPTION 1: Traditional Run/Walk/Bike or Lap Swim


* Volunteers and volunteer organization required for groups



- 1. Participants are encouraged to get together with others to coordinate and organize an event.
- 2. As a group or individually, raise money by collecting donations for completing a predetermined number of laps/distance/course/cannonballs, leading up to the event.
- 3. On the day of the event, participants are to complete the respective activity for the specified period of time.
- 4. Get creative and have fun with friends and family!

OPTION 2: Wet Snake Cannonballs


- * Pool required
- * Ensure space is available to enter and exit the pool at each lane.



- 1. Line participants up behind the starting block in lane or row one, fastest to slowest, if possible.
- 2. One by one, signal each participant to their activity by announcing "3, 2, 1, CANNONBALL".
- 3. "Cannonball" into the pool and swim to the other end of the pool.
- 4. At the end of the lane, participant should climb out of the pool and "cannonball" into Lane 2, then swim to the lane's end.
- 5. Repeat steps 1-4 in the next two lanes or rows.
- 6. We recommend 30 minutes for the activity. This may be increased depending on age group.

OPTION 3: Dry Snake Cannonballs

- * Land and 12 cones/visible markers needed.
- * Place 2 rows of 6 cones approximately 25 yards apart as shown in the diagram below. Ensure space between each cone for activity.




- 1. Line participants up behind the starting cone in lane or row one, fastest to slowest, if possible.
- 2. One by one, signal each participant to their activity by announcing "3, 2, 1, CANNONBALL".
- 3. Cannonball by completing 3 star jumps and run, skip, hop, bear crawl, etc. to the other end.
- 4. At the end of the row, participant should complete 3 additional star jumps, then run skip, hope, bear crawl, etc. to the row's end.

OPTION 4: Waves of Cannonballs

*Pool required

*Line up all participants around the outer edge of the pool with a safe distance between each person.



- 1. Announce "3, 2, 1, CANNONBALL" signaling the start of the activity.
- 2. The 1st participant gives their cannonball into the pool, followed by the 2nd participant, then the 3rd participant and so on in a domino, wave of cannonballs effect. **OR** Participants give their best cannonball into the water at the same time.
- 4. Repeat as many times as you wish!
- 5. We recommend 30 minutes for the activity.

OPTION 5: Create Your Own

As mentioned above, there are no required rules for how to do your cannonballs. Come up with your own creative way of displaying your "cannonballs" and let us know how you did it!

DOCUMENT THE MOMENT

Please help promote your **Cannonballs for a Cure** event with photos and videos before, during and after your event. Remember, our only rules are to **HAVE FUN and MAKE WAVES for DIPG**. All other guidelines are discretionary. Be creative!

After the Event

Congratulate Your Team

- 1. Congratulate all of your participants on doing a great job volunteering, raising money and joining in on your **Cannonballs for a Cure** event.
- 3. Collect all pledges within 48 hours of your event end and turn them into to your Organization Leader/Team Captain by the agreed upon deadline date.

- 4. Contact your Cannonballs Team contact to let them know your event is complete.
- 5. The deadline to submit donations to **Cannonballs for Kayne** in order to receive the correct participant awards is July 3, 2019. Mail Team/Participant name and check payments to: PO Box 1738, Ormond Beach, FL 32175.
- 6. Awards will ship to the Organization Leader/Team Captain the week of July 15th.
- 7. Share with us your experience, photos and videos from the event.
- 8. Have participants reach out to their donors and thank them for their support, sharing how much fun they had and how much was raised for the Team.
- 9. Consider setting a date for 2020 and have your participants mark it on their calendar.


