(1) Ladies Platinum Diamond Ring

Circa 1920s ring is centered with three (3), bezel set, marquise brilliant cut diamonds and is surrounded by twenty (20), bead/bezel set, round single cut diamonds and three (3), channel set, calibre' cut green glass. The gallery features a pierced design with floral motifs and bordered with milgrain edging. Engraved floral and wheat details accent the top half of the shank. The ring measures 20.9mm at the top, rises 4.3mm above the finger, tapering to 1.3mm wide and 0.7mm thick at the base of the shank.
