What we collect

By agreeing to be a fully signed up member of Save Mirfield, you will provide us with your personal details. We collect the following information:

- name
- telephone number
- address and postcode
- email address

We collect this information so that we can see if your home/land is directly affected by specific large scale planning applications and so we can keep you updated.

What we do with the information we gather

We require this information in order to:

- Keep you updated via email, telephone or in person with issues relating to large scale planning applications, events and fundraising activities
- List you within a group objection document. Your details are included in a list of all our members which accompanies a planning objection document and is submitted to Kirklees Council. Please note that Kirklees Council do not publish this information and adhere to their own GDPR and data protection
- Save Mirfield will keep your data for a period of 6 years.

Security

We are committed to ensuring that your information is secure. In order to prevent unauthorised access or disclosure, we have put in place suitable physical, electronic and managerial procedures to safeguard and secure the information we collect online and in person.

How we use cookies

A cookie is a small file which asks permission to be placed on your computer's hard drive. Once you agree, the file is added and the cookie helps analyse web traffic or lets you know when you visit a particular site. Cookies allow web applications to respond to you as an individual.
