#7615 Shipyard Employment

Shipyard employment includes ship repairing, shipbuilding and shipbreaking and is required by [NAVSEA 009-74](#):

3.21 Repair and maintenance employees working aboard vessels, dry docks and piers shall have a valid 10 hour OSHA Maritime Shipyard Employment Course #7615...within 60 days of employment.

Upon completion and training submission, OSHA 10-hour cards are distributed.
