Applicants Sought for New Greenville Habitat Homes

Greater Greenville Area Habitat for Humanity is seeking applicants for new homes to be built in Greenville within the next two or three years. Habitat for Humanity is a non-profit organization which uses volunteer labor to help deserving families become first-time homeowners by building their own houses.

The organization has completed 18 homes in Greenville. The use of volunteer labor has cut the cost of these three-bedroom, two-bath homes nearly in half.

To be considered, applicants must attend two public workshops in June. These two-hour meetings are scheduled for 3 p.m. on Sunday, June 11, and 3 p.m. on Sunday, June 25. The workshop sessions will begin promptly at 3 p.m. in the Nunnan Fellowship Hall at Greenville's First Presbyterian Church at 1 John Calvin Circle (at the corner of McAllister and Goldstein streets).

Full details of the Habitat home-owner partnership program will be provided at the meetings along with assistance in completing applications.
