CALL TO ORDER: Mayor Leppek called the Regular Council Meeting of May 9, 2018 to order at 7:31 p.m.

DELEGATION: CAROLINE BABIUK & MICHELLE ANDRIASHYK  
Caroline Babiuk with Alberta Health Services and Michelle Andriashyk with FCSS came to talk about the Rural Transportation Coalition. A needs assessment survey was developed, and they asked if the Village could help get it to the residents of Andrew. It was decided that the survey will be included with the utility bills.
