Explore how Bookform technology facilitates the framework of 'Universal Design Learning' to save you time and develop personalised student experiences & content for curriculum-aligned lessons and assessments. Compatible with Google classroom and any device.

Workshop details:

- **6.30-7pm STEAM Project - The Collaborative Book:** Experience how to use the Bookform online dashboard to automatically collect written content and photos from your class (up to 300 people) to create a collaborative class book. Students develop ICT, literacy, art and collaboration skills.
- **7-7:30pm The Family Book Project:** Participants will role-play an interview scenario using the voice-to-text technology to experience how a student would collect oral stories from their family or people in their community to scaffold authentic experiential learning and family engagement.
- **7:30-7.50pm Refreshment break**
- **7.50-8:30pm Classroom application:** Participants will explore how student collected content can be used for curriculum-aligned class lessons in English, History, ICT, Social Studies and more.

Outcomes:

- Teachers will learn how to automatically collate a classroom of student's content into a printable digital book as a STEAM Project. All participants will receive a copy of the Collaborative digital book created at the workshop.
- Teachers will explore how students can use the Bookform online tool to interview their family and community as experiential learning and the content used in classroom lessons & discussions, literacy & collaborative editing, presentation skills in class and at presentation ceremonies to engage families.

Presenter:

Carey Furze is the bookform founder, published author and presenter. Bookform was created as a resource for teachers to provide differentiated and experiential learning projects for their students, adhering to the 'Universal Design Learning' framework. Digital content can be used in the classroom for literacy lessons, collaborative editing and peer-bonding. Students have agency over the content they collect and an emotional interest in creating a polished end product they are proud to present.
