2. Is eternal life knowing God and Jesus through the Bible?
John 17:3
Yes! Turn to Ephesians 3:3-9.
3. Can we know God and His mysteries by reading the Bible?
Ephesians 3:3-9
Yes! Turn to 2 Peter 1:3.
4. Do we have everything that we need for life and godliness?
2 Peter 1:3
Yes! Turn to 2 Peter 1:20-21.
5. Did every word of Scripture come from God through the Holy Spirit?
2 Peter 1:20-21
Yes! Turn to 2 Timothy 3:14-17.
6. Does Scripture make you wise for salvation and equip you for every good work?
2 Timothy 3:14-17
Yes! Turn to John 8:51
7. Does this sound like a life or death statement to you?
John 8:51
Yes! Turn to John 12:47-50.
8. Will we be judged by how we obeyed the Word of God?
John 12:47-50
Yes! Turn to John 8:24.

Section #2 – The Key To Being Saved Is Faith In Jesus!

Yes! Turn to Matthew 16:13-17.
10. Does Jesus agree with Peter that he is the Christ, the Son of God?
Matthew 16:13-17
Yes! Turn to John 1:1-3, 14.
11. Does the Bible say that Jesus was God and came to live among us?
John 1:1-3, 14
Yes! Turn to Colossians 2:9.
12. Is Jesus the fullness of God in a human body?
Colossians 2:9
Yes! Turn to 1 Timothy 2:5.
13. Is Jesus our only mediator, or way back to God?
1 Timothy 2:5
Yes! Turn to Hebrews 2:14-18.
14. Did Jesus come to earth as a human so that He could understand us?
Hebrews 2:14-18
Yes! Turn to Matthew 27:46.
15. Did Jesus even find out about pain, sin, and disappointing God?
Matthew 27:46
Yes! Turn to Isaiah 59:2.

Section #3 – The Problem Or Disease We All Face Is Sin!

20. Do we become a sinner when we sin?

21. Is it important to be willing to admit, or confess, our sins?

27. Did Jesus die on the cross to pay for your sins?

28. Is it the blood of Jesus that actually saves us from our sins?

Yes! Turn to 1 Corinthians 15:17-23, 51-57.
29. His death is obviously important, but is His burial and resurrection important too?

37. If you are in Christ, is it true that you have the salvation that is in Jesus?

Yes! Turn to 1 John 5:11.
38. If you are in Christ, do you have eternal life?
1 John 5:11
Yes! Turn to John 14:6.
39. Is this the only way to be saved and have eternal life with God in heaven?
John 14:6
Yes! Turn to Matthew 7:21-23.

Section #5 – We Must Accept The Cure To Our Sin Problem!

Yes! Turn to Acts 2.
43. If you do what they did on the day of Pentecost in Acts 2, will the same thing happen to you today?

Yes! Turn to Acts 8:26-40.
44. Was the Ethiopian eunuch taught to obey the gospel by being baptized?
Acts 8:26-40
Yes! Turn to Matthew 16:24-27.
45. Does Jesus expect us to obey the gospel, dying on our own cross and following him?
Matthew 16:24-27
Yes! Turn to 2 Peter 2:20-22.
46. Does God expect a long-term commitment from you?
2 Peter 2:20-22
Yes! Turn to 2 Corinthians 6:2.
47. Does God seem to be saying that now is the time to be saved?
2 Corinthians 6:2
Yes! Turn to 2 Peter 3:9-10.
48. While God has been patient, hoping that people will repent and obey Him, will He someday cause the world to end suddenly?
2 Peter 3:9-10
Yes! Turn to Hebrews 2:2-3.
49. Since it is true that God has offered us salvation, will we deserve punishment if we refuse this salvation?

Yes! Turn to Acts 22:16.
