## Junior Cotillion of Temple

### The Dress Code\*

#### Dances

The **Junior Cotillion of Temple** desires that all Members feel both at ease and confident in their attire while dancing. The **Dress Code of the Junior Cotillion of Temple** is established and enforced in order to provide a safe and comfortable environment for its Members by limiting distractions and avoiding clothing mishaps.

All Junior Cotillion dances are dress-up occasions where careful grooming and dress is required. The attire of Junior Cotillion Members should be representative of the **Junior Cotillion of Temple**, the **Wildflower Guild**, and the **Central Texas Orchestral Society**.

The **Junior Cotillion of Temple** requires *all Junior Cotillion Members and Volunteers* to follow the **Dress Code of the Junior Cotillion of Temple**:

#### GIRLS

- Halter-tops or spaghetti straps may be worn *only if* the shoulders are covered with a sweater, shrug or light jacket *to be worn the entire dance*. A wrap is insufficient as it generally proves a distraction to the dancer.
- Sleeveless tops and dresses are allowed as long as undergarments are completely covered and the necklines are appropriate (no cleavage).
- NO STRAPLESS dresses or tops.
- The midriff may not be exposed.
- Hemlines of shorts, skirts, and dresses, when seated, must be mid-thigh or longer.
- Flip-flips and backless shoes are prohibited.

#### BOYS

- All pants shall be worn at the waist, with no sagging.
- A belt should be worn at all times.
- Athletic shoes are prohibited.

#### NOTE TO PARENTS

These guidelines are designed to protect your child's modesty and reputation and are not meant to make shopping difficult for you.

If your child comes to the Junior Cotillion dance wearing clothing that violates the **Dress Code of the Junior Cotillion of Temple**, your child will be asked to leave the dance until he or she is in compliance with the dress code.
