Expectations of Behavior

In order for to benefit fully from the Junior Cotillion experience and to maintain membership in the Junior Cotillion of Temple, Members must adhere to the following expectations and guidelines:

- **Members must RSVP by phone to their Dance Chairman whether or not** they are attending the dance. Not only is this proper social etiquette, but it's also a practical matter, as it allows us to be certain each dance has an equal number of boys and girls.
- **Members must arrive to and leave the dance on time.** As a matter of safety, parents must accompany Members into the venue and enter to pick up Members. Members will not be allowed to stand outside any venue and wait for parents after a dance.
- **Cell phones use is strictly prohibited** during all Junior Cotillion of Temple events. Cell phones will be taken up and held by a Dance Chairman and returned to the Member's parents at the end of the event.
- **Members must politely listen to and follow instructions** given by the Dance Instructor and all Junior Cotillion of Temple parent volunteers at dances, concerts, and etiquette events.
- **Members must graciously greet their dance partners** and introduce themselves. Members may not refuse a dance. Rude and offensive comments, expressions, and gestures are prohibited and will result in dismissal from the Junior Cotillion.
- **All dances have themes.** The dance invitation will include the correct attire to be worn. Members and parent volunteers must dress according to the theme of the dance. See the Dress Code of the Junior Cotillion of Temple for guidance.
- **The Dress Code of the Junior Cotillion of Temple** must be followed at all Junior Cotillion of Temple events.

Parents, prior to each concert, dance, or etiquette event, please review the Expectations of Behavior with your child.

So that all Members will enjoy their experiences at our events, the Expectations of Behavior will be enforced. Infractions may result in dismissal from the Junior Cotillion of Temple.

* RSVP, *répondez, s'il vous plait*, or "please respond," means that the person sending you the invitation requests that you either accept or decline the invitation.
