Apply March 1–June 1 2019

To meet researchers within your field, write a larger application or gather stakeholders and researchers for a conference or workshop: apply for SNS and EFINORD funding!

We want to promote North European synergies within forest research and establish closer collaboration between forest research communities. We also want to bridge gaps between research and practice.

Special focus This time we particularly encourage networks dealing with issues related to climate change mitigation and adaptation to apply for funding – we need to prepare for increased flooding, drought and wildfires in the future.

Successful proposals can also relate to the following focus areas:

- Meeting the demands of sustainable forest management in a growing bioeconomy
- Maintenance and increased utilisation of ecosystem services

- ▶ You can apply for up to 200 000 SEK.
- ▶ Networks should include participants from three research institutions in the Nordic region and three additional countries of relevance.
- ▶ The participants in the network must have a 40/60% gender balance and PhD students and young researchers should be included in the network.
- ▶ Networks are expected to co-finance at least 50% of the total budget.
