What your generous support has done for the safety of the boating community:

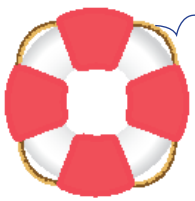
- Assisted the Boating Council in offering cost free safety education to our boating community in 2017 and again in 2018.

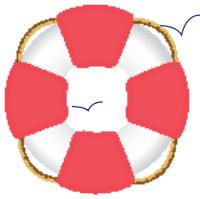

WATERFRONT FESTIVAL RULES

- Space must be paid in full before you will be allowed to set up.
- Vendors may set up at 7AM on Sunday, May 20th. A map with space assignments will be available at the GHCYBC Information Booth. No space assignments may be changed.
- Booth numbers will be displayed in the center of your space. Booth space is approximately 12' x 12'. Space requests will be given every consideration; however, final assignments will be made at the discretion of the event committee.
- Vendors must be set up by 9:30AM on the day of the event and all cars must be removed from the vendor area at this time. Parking outside of the vendor area will be available for all vendors.
- Vendors are responsible to supply their own booth or tables. Vendors should be prepared with plastic covers and secure tent weights. This is an outdoor show. There will be no cancellation of the event or a rain date due to weather. Refunds will not be given for any reason.
- Vendors may only sell merchandise that matches the general description provided within this application. Vendors selling any merchandise deemed inappropriate by the event committee will be asked to leave without a refund.
- The use of generators is strictly prohibited.
- As applicable, all vendors are required to display a valid Certificate of Authority (NYS Sales Tax Number).
- You are responsible for the cleanliness of your site. Please bring garbage bags to keep your area clean. You are responsible for keeping your assigned space clean and for bringing the trash to a dumpster or trash cans before you leave the event at the end of the day.
- All booths must close by 5:00PM. Cars will not be permitted in the vendor area until 5:30PM. Event area must be cleared by 7:00PM.

***All event rules will be strictly enforced. Persons not complying with event rules will be asked to leave without a refund.*

The undersigned, being fully aware of the risks and hazards inherent in participating in the Event, hereby voluntarily elects to engage in such activity and assumes all risk of loss, damage, or injury to person or damage to property, while engaged in such activity. This release shall be binding on the distributes, next of kin, heirs, personal representative and administrators of the undersigned or those of any individual who the undersigned is signing on behalf. The undersigned irrevocably grants to sponsors the right to use his/her likeness, identifying logo or trademark in photographs, film or video for promotional use in any and all media. Upon the undersigned vacating the assigned space, the undersigned agrees to leave said space in exactly the same state of cleanliness as when the undersigned initially occupied the space. Failure to comply with either of these conditions will result in the undersigned, or the undersigned's corporate entity, to be ineligible for any future GH-CYBC sponsored events. By signing this release, the undersigned hereby acknowledges and represents that he/she is of sound mind, has read this release, understands it and signs it voluntarily.
