Your job is to find out who the culprit is by solving the clues that have been left around Bulcote!

## Solving the Mystery

Solve the clues to find the murderer and murder weapon. The answers are names and numbers that you will find as you follow the Trail. Solve the clues to eliminate suspects and weapons. At the end of the Trail you should be left with one of each - case closed!

***Remember to take care. This is not a race. You are responsible for the safety of yourself and your party. Please take care when crossing the roads and rail tracks. Children stay with your parents and parents stay with your children. Staying safe is more important than finding a clue!!***

### Clue 1 – Old Main Road

Find the yellow sign with a big H. You need to do some sums to solve this one! Take the number that appears twice and times this by the bottom number. This is the year in the 18th Century to cross off!

### Clue 2 – Willow Cottage

Find a faint sign of what used to be here. Someone with the same name as the occupation on the sign can be erased.

### Clue 3 - Oaklands

Find a name located next to a town. You will need to look low. She did not commit the crime.

### Clue 4 - Sign for Bulcote Heritage Trail



Find this on the sign and locate the number that is directly opposite it to find an occupation of someone who would have lived there. This suspect can be wiped from your enquiries.

## **Clue 5** - Holly Lane

Walk down this dead end to reveal a house name of a suspect who is no murderer.

## **Clue 6** - Cottages.

This feline lady would not get her claws into this kind of scandal. She can be eliminated.

## **Clue 7** –Bulcote Church

Find the name of someone who gave the land that the pathway now sits on. He can be erased.

## **Clue 8** –Bulcote Church

Search around the back of the church for a gravestone with binoculars on it. What was the name of the man's wife? She is not the one to blame.

## **Clue 9** – Stables

Do not chicken out on this clue. This emergency number will eliminate a murder weapon.

## **Clue 10** - Crossroads

If you were to cycle from this point to Newark

and back, then on to Nottingham and finish in Gedling, how many miles would you have cycled? Find a weapon that has this number in it.

## **Clue 11** - Shaftesbury Avenue



There are plenty of these, but can you find the one close to a date that will enable you to eliminate a weapon?

## **Clue 12** - Gordon Road

Look to your right and take the first name of the house with 1894 on it and add it to the first name of the house with 1887 on it and you will find the name of another suspect to cross off.

## **Clue 13** - Railway

Before crossing the railway a suspect in the road needs to be eliminated

**Clue 14** - Road Back to the Farm

Both sides of this sign give you a clue to which weapon was not used.

**Clue 15** - Road Back to the Farm

This number will make sure the weapon is kept safe behind bars and not used for any murder.

**Clue 16** - Farm House

This farmer lives next to the Farm Rooms. This suspect can be struck off.
