**A612 NOTTINGHAM ROAD - BETWEEN BULCOTE AND LOWDHAM -
PROPOSED 50MPH SPEED LIMIT - (3295) - PUBLIC CONSULTATION**

Via East Midlands Ltd, working on behalf of Nottinghamshire County Council, is proposing to introduce a 50mph speed limit on Nottingham Road (A612) between Bulcote and Lowdham. The new speed limit would replace the existing National Speed Limit (60mph). The limit would run between the existing 40mph speed limits in Bulcote and Lowdham.

The proposed speed limit is being introduced in response to requests and reflects the recommendations made in the A and B Road Speed Limit Review which produced a recommendation for all the A and B roads in Nottinghamshire.

Before proceeding further, I wish to consider the views of residents, businesses and organisations who may be interested in this matter. If your comments are in the form of an objection to the proposals and if they cannot be resolved, they will be reported through the County Council's procedures at the appropriate time. Any observations on these proposals should reach me in writing, either by letter (address at bottom of letter) or email, by **12th August 2019**.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be to roads in Bulcote and Lowdham in the District of Newark and Sherwood:-

Nottingham Road (A612) in Bulcote and Lowdham in the District of Newark and Sherwood

1. from a point 47 metres north-east of the centre line of the north-eastern junction with Old Main Road, Bulcote in a north-easterly direction to a point 146 metres south-east of its junction with Skithorne Rise, Lowdham.

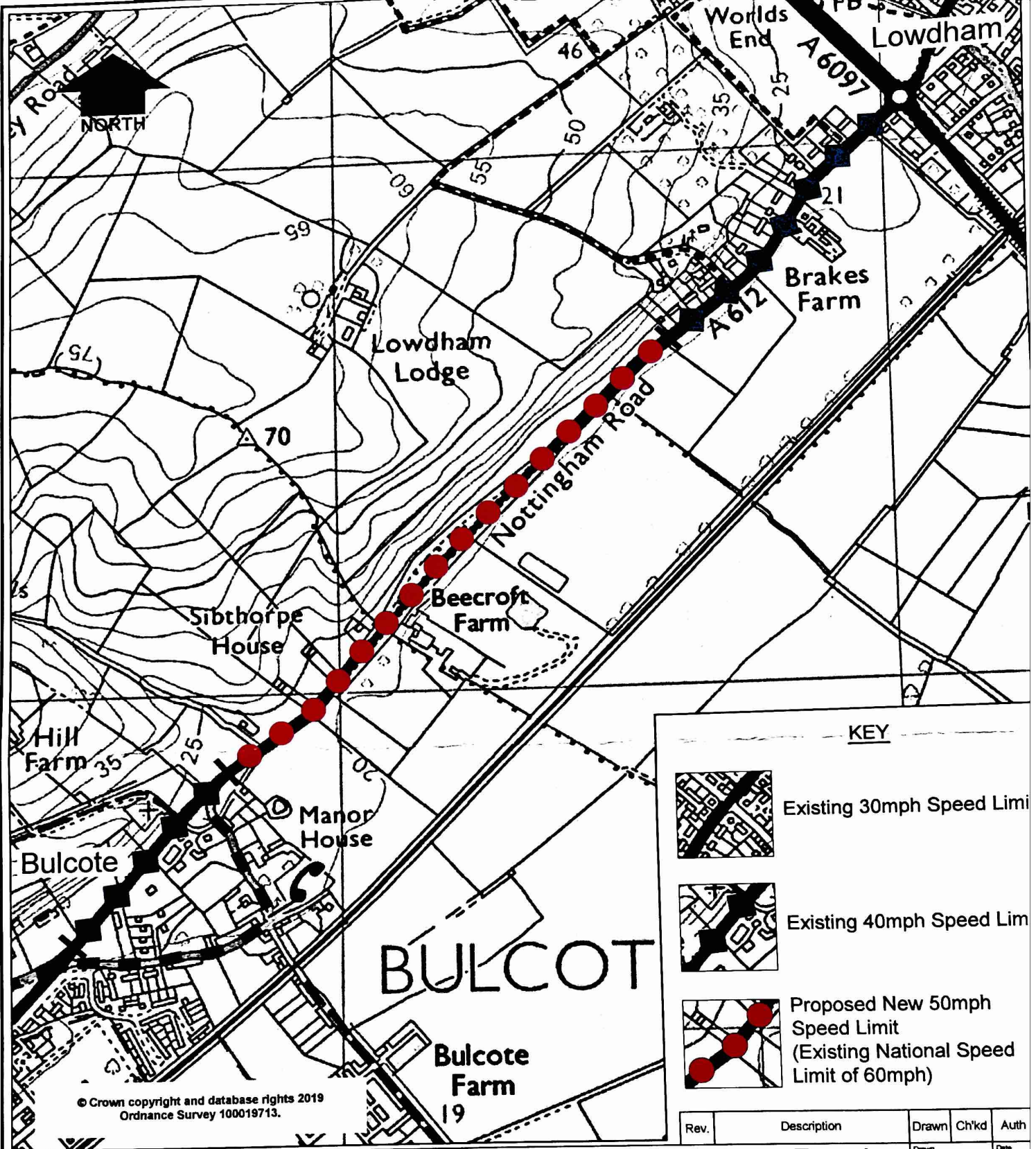


