HKS Professor Cristine Russell is looking for a Research/Course Assistant for academic year 2018-19. The job would include fall research/writing projects and syllabus prep for the Spring 1 Module IGA451M: Controversies in Climate, Energy & the Media: Improving Public Communication, a small (20+), lively, discussion-based class. It is a great way to engage with how we talk about current issues in climate change, energy, and the environment and how to communicate with the general public and politicians in an age of "alternative facts" and climate denialism. Professor Russell, a longtime science journalist and senior fellow in HKS' Environment & Natural Resources Program, is very fun to work with.

The position is for the full academic year: time commitment in Fall is 6-8 hrs /week (very flexible timing); in Spring 1 module it's 8-12 hours/week including time spent in class, helping with class blog, etc; Spring 2 is much less time and more flexible. Prof. Russell will be interviewing candidates in next few weeks.
