ONE STUDENT AT A TIME

Students are looked at individually through a holistic approach to determine what they need both academically and emotionally in order to succeed.

STRATEGIES

Students are looked at individually and holistically to determine what they need both academically and emotionally in order to succeed.

Students are assessed academically to see what level they are at in each subject.

Students are assessed, where necessary, by various therapists and all areas of weakness are addressed and included in an individualised plan for the school year.

Each student has an individualised plan created at the beginning of the school year by a learning team (including parents and students), that includes academic targets, social goals, physical goals, independence goals, emotional goals, leadership goals, real world learning opportunities/internships and personal interests.

Plans are followed and monitored closely throughout the year, specifically at the end of each school term and adjusted where necessary.



We believe that students learn best when they are engaged and involved in their learning process.

Junior students are given both independent and assigned projects throughout the year to help them engage in personal interests and topics being covered.

Senior students have internships every year with mentors for their chosen areas of interest.

Senior students are expected to produce authentic projects bi-annually and make public presentations based on their work and research. Their internships are included in the project.

Year 12 students who are graduating have to create a thesis project throughout their senior year that is based on their internship work.

ASSESSMENT

Each student is assessed according to their own abilities and never compared to another.

Individual projects are presented throughout the year in front of peers, teachers and outsiders in order to receive constructive feedback.

Students' grades and academic achievements are compared to no one's other than their own. A student should never feel that they are lesser than another based on anything but their own effort.

Students build strong portfolios throughout their school life at BTBE that show their progress to themselves and others.

Teachers give individual feedback to students based on their work rather than just awarding grades.

LEADERS OF TOMORROW


