- Contest Rules and Regulations:
 - The 2018 winner will carry the **title of Young Miss Railroad Days.**
 - Contestants must agree to abide by all rules of the Young Miss Railroad Days contest that are in effect now or as announced later. Contestants agree that the time, manner, and method of judging shall be solely at the discretion of the Railroad Days Organization and the decision of the judges will be final.
 - Contestant must be a resident of Randolph County. Parents, please provide a copy of personal mail or utility bill to **verify residency.**
 - Contestants shall be between the ages of 7 to 10 years. Please provide a photo copy of contestant's birth certificate for **age verification.**
 - Selection of the Young Miss Railroad Days will be based on the following scoring basis:
 - ❖ 50% Stage Appearance
 - ❖ 50% Judges 5 minute Interview
 - ❖ **Dress Code** – Summer attire. *No pageant dresses, please.*

 - Completed entry forms and documentation must be received by **June 4, 2018.** Photo copies of age and residency documentation are permissible. A complete entry will include:
 - \$5.00 Entry Fee
 - Completed official entry form
 - Completed official information sheet for emcee
 - Copies of documentation for age and residency
 - Good quality 4 x 6 photo

 - **The winners and runners-up will remain for a short time immediately following the contest for publicity photos.**

 - The Young Miss will assist at various events throughout the current Railroad Days event and be expected to crown the new queen the following year. Other events, such as parades, etc., may be offered throughout the year but are optional. Depending on winner's availability due to prior commitments with family, school, church or work, Young Miss will participate at the discretion of the parents.

 - If queen earns an additional title **after** being crowned Young Miss Railroad Days, that will run concurrent to her RRDS reign, queen will represent Miss Railroad Days during appropriate, conflicting events. (Good examples are Moberly Parades – Homecoming, Veteran's Day and Christmas Parades.) Contact pageant director Pretz for help if a conflict arises.
