Veterans Museum: The veterans program will be held on November 5, 2022 starting at 11:00. In December the Santa Day will be held a time has not been listed yet.

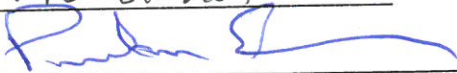
Old Business:
