Shawntel Robinson wanted to thank the Mayor and Stephen Craig for the signs In God we trust being purchased and hung in the court room.

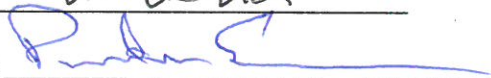
