The Vilonia City Council meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Mayor James Firestone.

Members present: Shawntel Brown, Sherry Clements, Joe Maxwell, Jim King, Kathy French. A quorum was declared.

Approval of April 2018 minutes – Motion for approval made by Councilman King, seconded by Councilman Maxwell, no discussion, motion carried.

Emergency Management – Keith Hillman presented. Fire runs have been slowing down. Medical calls have been up the last few weeks.

Planning Commission – Keith Hillman presented. Planning Commission has a meeting this month. 5 new housing inspections this month.

Police Department – Chief McNew presented. Police department now has Narcan with officers in their vehicles. Grant money was received and new computers were purchased for police vehicles. Once invoice is received, the invoice will be sent to the State and the police department will be reimbursed 90%. 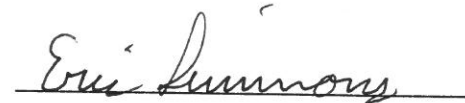

No new business.

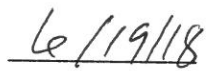
