Purpose: To encourage students in the study of the organ.

This scholarship may be used for:

- A) Organ lessons with a scholarship committee-approved teacher. *(details to be worked out with teacher and committee max \$420)*
- B) Tuition and/or books toward further organ study.
- C) Workshops and/or Pipe Organ Encounters (POE) for students and other items related to improving organ skills.

Requirements

- 1. Basic proficiency in piano, harpsichord, keyboard or organ playing.
- 2. Residency State of Maine resident.
- 3. Age No restrictions.
- 4. Application Fee None.

The following must be included with your completed application:

- 1. A digital recording 5-7 minutes.
- 2. A written recommendation from a music teacher.
