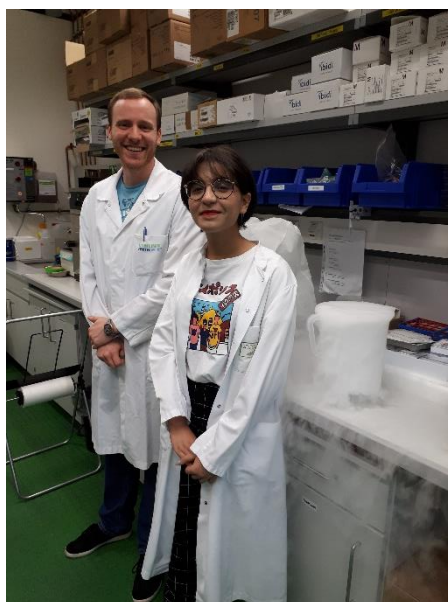


## Girls' Day supported by SFB-TRR219 !
