


The Schedule of FIABCI Young Members Visit Taiwan

8:30-10:00 **Cultural Heritage Park, Ministry of Culture** Address: No.362, Sec. 3, Fuxing Rd., South Dist., Taichung City

The Taichung Cultural and Creative Industry Park promoted by the Cultural Assets Bureau of the Ministry of Culture (formerly the Cultural Construction Committee of the Executive Yuan) was originally the fifth winery of the Taiwan Tobacco and Alcohol Marketing Bureau, also known as the Taichung Old Winery. Its predecessor was founded in 1916 in the Japanese era. It was originally a privately owned "Taisho Brewing Co., Ltd.". It was officially owned by the Japanese government in 1922. It was sold by the Taiwan Chief Executive in 1945 after the Second World War. The Taichung



Branch of the Bureau took over, and the government was transferred to public sales in 1947. It was taken over by the Taiwan Provincial Tobacco and Alcohol Marketing Bureau. It took less than a hundred years and traveled through many different historical contexts. The Taichung old winery, which was formerly the fifth winery of the public sales bureau, moved to Taichung Industrial Zone due to urban development and environmental considerations. The park is located near the railway station in Taichung City, covering an area of 5.6 hectares. It is currently the most intact of the five largest wineries in Taiwan.

After the Taichung Distillery was relocated to the new factory in Taichung Industrial Zone, the old winery left a large industrial heritage and historical buildings, which is enough to witness the history of the Taiwanese wine industry since the Japanese occupation. So in July 2002, it was registered as a history by the Taichung City Government. Construction, and the State-owned Property Bureau allocated 5.6 hectares of land and building ownership to the Cultural Assets Bureau of the Ministry of Culture (formerly the Cultural Construction Committee of the Executive Yuan), which allowed the site of the Taichung Winery to be completely preserved and obtained the Cultural Assets Bureau of the Ministry of Culture (previously The Executive Yuan Cultural Construction Committee plans to develop one of the five creative cultural parks in the creative industry development plan - "Taichung Cultural and Creative Industry Park", as a Taiwan cultural and creative industry promotion base, and develop into a Taiwanese architecture, design and art exhibition center.

In addition, the "Cultural Assets Bureau of the Ministry of Culture", the central competent authority in charge of cultural assets related businesses throughout Taiwan, is also established here. Its policy promotion goal is to effectively combine local governments, colleges and universities, civil and community organizations, shape a complete cultural asset protection network, construct an ecological environment that is in line with the development of cultural assets, and promote international cooperation in the preservation of cultural assets.



10:00-11:00 **Miyahara**

Built in 1927, Miyahara Ophthalmology was the largest ophthalmology clinic in

Taichung during the Japanese occupation. It was defeated in Japan, and the ophthalmology became Taichung Health Center. It was located in the Taichung Mayor Residence in Shuangzhong Road, Taichung City. It was originally a Japanese physician. The villa house built by Miyahara Takeo is located on the 3rd floor overlooking the Water Source Park and the Taichung Yizhong Campus. It



was a well-known mansion in Taichung City. After the war, although Taichung Shizhao including Lin Xiantang had expressed his feelings to the National Government, Miyahara Takeo was still repatriated to Japan, and his residence and hospital were deemed "Nissan" and confiscated, becoming Taichung City Government property.

Dr. Miyahara is a Ph.D. in ophthalmology. He served as the dean of a public hospital. He



re-opened his post in 1926 and started his own "Miyahara Hospital" in Taichung City in 1930, mainly in ophthalmology, and his hospital is currently In the area of Green River in front of Taichung Railway Station, it has 30 beds, which was the largest private hospital in Taichung City.

National Taichung Theater is a continuation of the 1987 completion of the National Concert Hall and Theater. After nearly 30 years since the first opening of a national performance venue, NTT is a 21st-century cultural facility that is not only a new landmark in the city, but also represents a cultural step forward. Taichung is located in the geographical heart of Taiwan and is a city with a storied, profound cultural heritage. Now, for this city's energetic, lively, and ambitious people, we have created this stunning world-class performance and exhibition facility. In 2005, the Pritzker Architecture Prize winner, Toyo Ito,

won the extremely competitive international contest to design our theater, besting contestants from 13 countries, and delivering to us this magnificent 21st-century artistic venue.

Toyo Ito pondered that if the natural world is constantly changing, and every living thing never stops changing, then why is it that buildings never change? "I am always searching for a building which is something like a ripple on a river-- one that can

follow the river's

currents but maintain its own spatial integrity." Because of this thought, Toyo Ito broke all traditional concert hall rules of sealed structures, creating a theater composed almost completely of curved walls. The walls flow into the ceilings with no clear boundaries dividing them. In fact, the entire space flows without boundaries, allowing the venue to host nearly any type of event.



The theater is like whirlpool in central Taiwan, the crowds striving for a cosmopolitan flavor will be attracted and flow inwards, causing the arts to seep into every corner of the city. Also because of its special construction, Toyo Ito described this building as one you use your ears to listen to. Accompanied by the theater's natural lighting which constantly changes, when you walk through the theater you hear different sounds, producing unique sensations. This building is not just being used for opera, the building itself is an opera. Enter the hall, and you begin a transformative journey through this ingeniously-designed opera.

The venue has six stories, featuring the Grand Theater, Playhouse, a magical Sky Garden and a shopping center. On the second basement level there are Black Box, Rehearsal

Rooms, and a mechanical room. Outdoors there are a fountain, Outdoor Plaza and Outdoor Theater. From the outside you can view the curved, concrete walls and glass screens which majestically adorn the building. This "Teapot Residence" shape is a metaphor, for all who enter the theater will be intoxicated with delight by the artistic contents that reside within.

The Central Range Is Bamboo Chic in 2018 WAF Shortlist

With World Architecture Festival Awards (WAF) announcing this year's shortlist at the end of June, the Bamboo Pavilion, World Flora Exposition, is nominated among others. Situated in Huludun Park, Fengyuan, the creation, under the sponsorship of Taichung Real Estate Development Association, is designed by architect Chen Yi-chong of Zuo Studio over the image concept of seeds, bamboo forest and the Central Range. The structure and weaving display a form of bamboo forest, allowing visitors to take a unique bamboo forest walk among the floral park.

The industrial critic and academic research award, WAF, is nominating 7 Taiwanese projects this year from Office to House and Commercial mixed-use. The Bamboo Pavilion, of all, entered the category of Leisure Led Development - Future Project. The award is to take place in Amsterdam this November, followed by a three-day architecture forum. The project team Zuo Studio will be live presenting to the panel of the design concept and inviting the industry to visit Taichung Flora Expo.

In place of concrete, "Bamboo Pavilion" adopted the ubiquitous, thriving bamboo in Taiwan as green material to strike a balance between architecture and the natural environment with sustainable components. Upon creating a novel experience of designed space, the project advocates historic development of oriental bamboo craft, says architect Chen Yi-chong.

Taichung Flora Expo is a journey where the walkable, cozy Bamboo Pavilion is incorporated in curves, blending into background and coexisting with Mother Nature. Bring yourself among the flow of light and wind, discover a brand new space at each step, a new finding at every angle. "Visitors are triggered with more imagination towards the forms of architecture and the interaction in between."

As per Economic Development Department, "Bamboo Pavilion" is Taiwan's only public construction nominated in WAF, solidifying the strength of Taichung architecture while leaving a great achievement in promoting Taichung city aesthetics. The shortlisted project is the best acknowledgement to public participation to the Flora Expo. Not only the event showcases flowers and horticultural skills, the presentation of outstanding architect, design teams and artists, as well as the public and private organizations collaboration, are shining from local to global stage.

Master Xi-Kun Wang is a second-generation traditional drum maker and the owner of Xiang Ren He Drum Factory. His family has been in this business for more than 80 years, making Xiang Ren He Drum Factory a recognized historical landmark in the Hsin-Chuang region.

In 2002, Master Wang started seeking innovative ways to enrich people's lives through his drums and through sound therapy. He founded Xiang Ren He Drum Cultural Center, a place for all to learn the art and history behind traditional drum making. Foreign visitors to the annual Hsin-Chuang International Drum Festival are encouraged to visit the Xiang Ren He Drum Cultural Center to understand the background stories of Taiwanese drum.



Master Wang believes that drum making is an artwork that should be preserved to future generations. "The drum itself is alive because the drumhead was made from a living creature. Through the reuse of the creature's skin, we hope its life would bring the world not only music, but also encouragement and enlightenment to the people. This is our mission."



In 2009, Xiang Ren He was registered by the Taipei County Government as one of the Taipei County's finest traditional arts. During the same year, Master Wang was awarded the "Taipei County Arborist Traditional Arts Award." In 2010, he was enlisted as Councilor of Cultural Affairs (CCA) as a Cultural Heritage technology preserver. Currently, he is regarded as a national living treasure of Taiwan.




19:45-21:00 **Super art drama group** "A Chance Encounter Leads Marriage"
