












#### Q5: Do you support Brett Kavanaugh as Supreme Court Justice?




Q6: If the 2020 General Election for North Carolina Governor were held today would you vote for Republican Dan Forest, Democrat Roy Cooper or undecided?

Q7: If the 2020 General Election for President were held today, would you vote for Republican Donald Trump, Democrat Joe Biden or undecided?




#### Q8: What is your opinion of the North Carolina General Assembly?




#### Q10: What is your opinion of Dan Forest?




#### Q12: What is your opinion of Capitalism?









#### Q14: Do you support expanding Medicaid in North Carolina?

Q15a: If you knew the majority of individuals eligible for Medicaid were single, able-bodied adult men, would you still support Medicaid expansion?












## Q16: What best describes your feelings toward the North Carolina Association of Educators rally on May 1?




## Q17: Who do you think should be responsible for drawing redistricting maps?

# Q18: Do you support North Carolina allowing small business employers to offer an association health insurance plan?




Q19: Charter schools and vouchers are good things because all parents deserve the opportunity to send their children to the best schools possible. Do you Agree or Disagree?




## Q21: Do you currently have a child or children in K-12 schools in North Carolina?

# Q22: Do you consider yourself to be Very Conservative, Somewhat Conservative, Moderate, Somewhat Liberal or Very Liberal?




## Q23: Are you a registered Republican, Democrat or Independent in North Carolina?

### Q24: What is your gender?


