Leaders from almost all of the 30+ State Basketball Coaches Associations that make up the National High School Basketball Coaches Association participated in the Annual NHSBCA Summer Conference in Raleigh, NC in July 10-13, 2018. Representatives from states that could not attend were provided the opportunity for input.

The vast majority of the 4 day meetings in Raleigh were spent preparing for the new June NCAA Scholastic Recruiting opportunity. Robust discussions took place encompassing the tremendous breadth and depth of experiences and expertise of the coaches. A strong collaborative effort in the “working groups” developed structure, standards, and desired outcomes for possible models for the June events.
