Reason: Ohio API Program Requirements and Operations		

To all Metrc Integration Partners, we have an important update regarding the Metrc API program for the state of Ohio.

The Metrc API will be the same RESTful JSON-based API you have worked with in other states such as Colorado and Oregon, but with some adjustments related to dispensaries. All existing functions regarding Vendor API Key, User API Key, Authentication, Authorization, Harvests, Items, Lab Tests, Packages, Patients, Plant Batches, Plants, Rooms, Sales Receipts and Strains remain unchanged.

Ohio has requirements regarding a “Product Identifier” that is required for dispensations made by the dispensaries through their Point of Sale provider that differ from other Metrc instances. This new “Product Identifier” has been added to assist dispensaries with controlling and proper administration of dispensing of product to patients and allow them to submit. Important aspects of the program:

- The “Product Identifier” will be prepended to the item/product’s name after the state has approved the item/product.
- All sales receipts are required to perform a “GET” on active packages to validate the Product Identifiers available at the dispensary.
- Sales to patients are required to be posted in “real-time,” meaning as soon as the sale has been made to the patient the sale needs to be posted to Metrc immediately.

This new functionality will help the dispensaries ensure product is not over dispensed at single or multiple locations. Since the “Product Identifier” will be part of the item/product name, there are no new endpoints to integrate with. We have highlighted the location of the “Product Identifier” within the following package:

If you wish to be validated for Ohio, please review the following points:

- The state of Ohio requires the completion of proficiency tests prior to being provided an API key. The new functionality will be part of the tests. Integrators are encouraged to take a refresher course prior to taking the test and performing the functions in the sandbox.

The process for receiving an API key is as follows:

- Download, complete and submit the Ohio API user agreement.
 - Agreements should be emailed to Brian.peters@com.state.oh.us and paula.economus@pharmacy.ohio.gov.
- Attend a Metrc API training (optional for vendors who have already attended a training; mandatory for new vendors) and complete the on-line test (mandatory).
- Complete your development work using the Ohio Metrc sandbox.
- Complete the evaluation form.
