Dear Parents and Guardians,

This will be the final newsletter for 2016.

Well done to all the students at the dress rehearsal on Saturday. A few things to remember for concert day.

- **ALL female students** (excluding Actors) require **TAN FOOTED TIGHTS**, these need to be purchased from **Bloch or Spangles**. **No pink ballet tights or stirrups**.
- Please check you have **no holes or ladders** in your tights.
- **No jewelry** to be worn on stage, this includes ear rings, if your child is unable to take their ear rings out please cover with skin coloured tape.
- **No fake tattoos**, nail polish or hair feathers.
- **Please** use hair ties that match your child's hair colour.
- If you have a hair piece or hat, please bring **lots of bobby pins**.
- **ALL Female students require the following make up-** Foundation, blusher, powder, brown toned eye shadow, eyeliner for top lid, mascara and red lipstick. If you only do **Acting** you will need, foundation, blusher, powder and natural lip colour.
- **ALL Male students require the following make up-** Foundation, blusher, powder and natural lips. If you need help with this, please let me know.

CONCERT DAY – TUESDAY DECEMBER 6th at the Glen St Theatre Blackbutts Rd, Belrose.

ARRIVAL TIMES for onstage rehearsal – (Please note this is not a dress rehearsal, students to wear The Tap Scene uniform)

- **Jazz A and Beginner Tap 1- 12pm to 1:30pm** (If your child isn't involved in any other class, they may leave the rehearsal once they have finished, please be back at the theatre by **5:30pm with hair and make up done** and ready for the concert)
- **ALL Musical Theatre Students – 12:30pm to 5:15pm**
- **Acting A -1pm to 2pm approximately** you may take your child after they have finished (please be back at the theatre by **5:30pm with hair and make up done** and ready for the concert)
- **ALL other students- 1pm to 5:15pm**

The show will start at **6:15pm sharp**, all students to be ready with correct hair, make up and first costume on by **5:45pm**. Please refer to the **Let's go to the Movies** program so you can get your child ready for their first item in the concert.

Please enter the theatre via the **side entrance** not the main entrance.

Please be on time.

Parents and Guardians are responsible for their children during the rehearsal in the dressing room. Myself and Miss Brianna will be down in the theatre running the rehearsal.

If you can't be at this rehearsal due to work commitments, please speak to another parent to organise supervision for your child, or perhaps you could work it in shifts.

If you need help contacting other parents, please let me know.

For the evening show, I have employed staff to help your child with costume and hair changes, so you can sit back and enjoy the show.

Please ensure you label all your child's belongings including all shoes.

Please pack a quiet activity for your child, please avoid texters, these might spoil costumes.

Please avoid packing food and snacks that will make a mess. Pack water bottles.

Please bring your costumes on a hanger in a costume bag, so you don't lose any items. Clothes racks will be supplied.

All hired costumes will be collected at the end of the concert, please pack something for your child to wear home.

Concert Tickets- Tickets are selling fast, limited seating is available. Go to www.glenstreet.com.au/box-office/ to purchase tickets.

Participation Medals: To thank my students for their hard work throughout 2016, they will be presented with The Tap Scene participation medal. Medals will be presented on **Monday November 28th, Tuesday November 29th, Wednesday November 30th and Thursday December 1st**. Parents and Guardians are invited to the **last 5 minutes** of your child's **last class** for the week, to watch the presentation.

If your child is interested in returning to **The Tap Scene** in 2017, please email what classes they are interested in. **Enrolments don't roll over**, you will have to re enroll and there will be cut off date, after which I will take in new enrolments.
