TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1 PAYMENT

- 1.1 Each Term will follow the school terms, of which there are four.
- 1.2 Invoices will be provided to parents / guardians at the beginning of each term.
- 1.3 Student Fees are payable by week two of each term, and late payment fees of \$20 may be charged per class, where payments remain outstanding after week two. Children may not be able to participate in class where fees remain outstanding.
- 1.4 Fees are charged for the entire term and are non refundable. Adjustments will be made to invoices for classes falling on a public holiday.
- 1.5 No credit is given for missed classes.
- 1.6 Fees can be paid via internet banking, cheque or cash. Any fees incurred due to returned cheques will be charged to the student account.

2 CLASSES

- 2.1 Classes will be run according to the class timetable which will be finalised in the first two weeks of term, and remain in place for the remainder of term.
- 2.2 Where possible classes established at the start of the year will remain at those times throughout the year, however, this cannot be guaranteed.
- 2.3 Students should be punctual to class and come prepared to learn with the appropriate uniform.
- 2.4 Details on the uniform for the students classes can be found by contacting THE TAP SCENE, and a uniform guide for each genre will be provided at the start of the year.
- 2.5 It is the responsibility of the parent / guardian to deliver the student inside the class premises, and pick them up at the completion of the class. The TAP SCENE is not responsible for the student until the child has been delivered to the premises and the class has started. The students are to remain on the premises until an authorised person picks them up.
- 2.6 As part of teaching dance and acting classes it may be necessary for the teacher to have a degree of physical contact between themselves and the student. This will only be for the purpose of teaching and guiding the student in improving their skills in the specific classes.
- 2.7 In delivering the classes and with the aim of improving the student's skills, technique and ensuring a safe and fun environment, it may be necessary for the teacher to provide constructive criticism or feedback to the student.
- 2.8 If at any stage the students behaviour becomes disruptive or disrespectful to the class or the teacher, the student may be asked to sit out the class or part of the class. Where the behaviour continues, THE TAP SCENE reserves the right to remove the child from the school. Abusive and/or disruptive parents/guardians may also result in the Child being removed from the school.

3 STUDENT IMAGES

- 3.1 Images may be taken of students whilst undertaking classes, performing at eisteddfods or concerts and used on THE TAP SCENE Website, Facebook and Instagram, for the purpose of promoting the school or advising the community of events related to the students at the school. You must inform THE TAP SCENE in writing if you will not permit such use of images.

4 MEDICAL EMERGENCY

- 4.1 Permission is given to THE TAP SCENE, its owners and operators to seek medical treatment for the student in the event of an accident or illness that in the opinion of the teacher requires Medical attention. The teacher will first attempt to contact a parent or guardian to make this decision, but where they cannot be contacted, the teacher will make this decision.
- 4.2 It is the responsibility of the parent / guardian to inform THE TAP SCENE in writing of any physical conditions, restrictions, or other conditions concerning the child. Where this has not been provided in writing it will be understood that the student has no existing issues inhibiting them in class and is in good physical and mental condition.

5 LIMITATION OF LIABILITY

- 5.1 As the legal parent or guardian, I understand that whilst the children's safety is of paramount importance to THE TAP SCENE, in the event of any loss, damage, injury or death, I release and hold harmless THE TAP SCENE, its owners and operators from any and all liability, claims, demands, costs and expenses, including without limitation reasonable legal fees, arising out of or related to any loss, damage, or injury, including death, that may be sustained by the student and/or the parent / guardian or their authorised contacts, while in or upon the premises or any premises under the control and supervision of THE TAP SCENE, its owners and operators or in route to or from any of said premises.

6 ANNUAL CONCERT AND COSTUMES

- 6.1 Where THE TAP SCENE is to put on a concert at the end of the year, it will be compulsory for all students to attend rehearsals and the concert.
- 6.2 A Costume Fee will be added to your Term 3 invoice for costume fees for the concert.
- 6.3 Costumes cannot be issued until all student fees and costume fees have been paid.
- 6.4 In term four, some classes may be interrupted as we prepare for the concert, eg costume fitting. THE TAP SCENE will endeavour to keep all disruptions to a minimum.
