To be eligible for the Joint Civic Committee of Italian Americans Joseph Cardinal Bernardin Scholarship, applicants must be a male student who is already enrolled in an accredited college/university, or is a senior in high school and accepted for enrollment by an accredited college/university, has a grade average of 3.75 or higher (on a scale of 4.0) and who is of full Italian ancestry or 50% Italian ancestry.

Applications, together with two letters of recommendations and transcript of grades, must be returned to the Joint Civic Committee of Italian Americans office no later than September 30, 2019.

Letters of recommendations must include one from a teacher and one from a counselor. Transcripts of credits must be the most recent, including ACT or SAT scores (if applicable).

Please include a small photo.

The scholarship award is \$2,000 and the presentation will take place October 14, 20189 at our Columbus Day festivities.
