

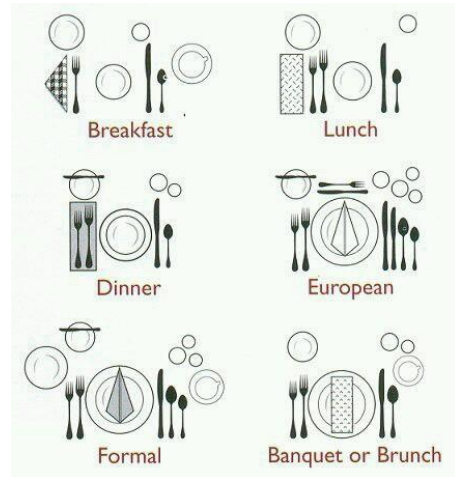
HAPPY HOLIDAYS 2016
