Applications

When are application deadlines? Different decisions: Early Action, Binding, Early Decision, Regular Decision, Rolling? **December Early Action (non-binding). Deadline for honors or scholarships is Dec. 1. March 1 Rolling Admission Deadline for upcoming fall semester, afterward if space is available.**

****Many of the colleges within the university recommend applying by the Early Action Deadline. College of Music by Nov 1st.**

Is an essay required for all decision options? **Yes, the common application essay and a personal statement**

Are letters of recommendation required or suggested? **They are optional but strongly recommended because they are used for scholarships.**

Is an in-person interview required or suggested? **For some majors it is required.**

Does the school use the Common App? **yes** How many applicants are received per year? **21,897 (2018)**
54% get first choice major, 60.4% get first or second choice major and 75.8% admission to main campus.

How much is the application fee? **\$50** Are there quotas for applicant acceptance?

NCAA Criteria, (Division I, II, etc.)? **Division I There is football but basketball is the bigger sport.**

Are sporting events free? Is there a ticket lottery? **They are free.**

Do freshmen live on campus? Are cars allowed? **Must live on campus first year. Cars are allowed. Pay for parking.**

What are the dorms like: hall-style, suite-style, or apartment-style? **Living & Learning Dorms? All styles – suites, rooms, shared and community bathrooms. Dorms are decided on a first come first serve basis. There are learning communities and Learning communities**

Campus Life (requirements, restaurants/cafeterias, clubs/activities, etc.) **Over 600 clubs. Varsity sports. Club sports. Intramural Sports.**

Campus is in an urban setting but not as in much as a school like GT.
