Is the Rep a school Alum? No **Is the Rep involved in the admissions process?** Yes, with medical & dental scholars programs

Freshman Profile: GPA – 3.33 SAT – 1140 CR/MA ACT – 27

GPA – How is it calculated? Core, weighted 4.0 Scale

ACT/SAT – Written Portion? No **Super Score?** SAT and ACT are superscored for admission to general programs. Only SAT is superscored for the medical and dental program ACT is the composite score

What are the average AP requirements? No minimum

Extra-Curricular Activities – What does the school look for? Looked at for honors scholarships, not regular admission

Most popular majors at this school: College of Health & Science (about 60% of students are enrolled here)

Does chosen major affect decision process? No

Study Abroad Programs? Yes, offered over breaks: spring, summer, fall, winter breaks. Freshman can participate

Internships / Co-Op Opportunities? Readily available especially for students in health science. Cancer & research center. Can do research as early as the 1st semester. Can volunteer/ shadow at Regents Hospitals.

Research Opportunities? Yes. Research I University. Student Centered.

Special successes the school is known for: Medical College is 13th oldest. Only dental school in GA. Largest nursing college in GA.

Medical Scholars is a very competitive program. Only 35-40 students are admitted with no waiting list.

What does the school look for in each “round” of decisions? **Same**

Does the school use the Common App? **No** How many applicants are received per year?

How much is the application fee? **\$50** Are there quotas for applicant acceptance? **No**
