**GPA -How is it calculated? Core. Unweighted. On a 4.0 scale.**

**ACT/SAT – Written Portion not required. No Super score.**

**Most popular majors at this school: 300+ majors. Top notch Journalism program. Offers Engineering, Business & Nursing. Law school, medical school and veterinary school on campus. 5 year Master's program available for Education, Accounting and Journalism.**

**Study Abroad Programs? Summer Programs, Semester-Long Programs, Foreign Language Programs? Multiple opportunities in 50+ countries. Semester and academic year programs.**

**Internships / Co-Op Opportunities? Yes. Mizzou is the only university to have an on-campus NBC studio. The station is run entirely by students. Freshman are eligible to work there.**

**Research Opportunities? Multiple opportunities for undergrad students.**

**Special successes the school is known for: On-campus NBC studio. 7 hospitals/clinics on campus.**

**Scholarships: Are there any specific to our area or for Georgia students? No.**

**When are scholarship deadlines? Applicants are automatically considered for some scholarships. The deadline for the competitive scholarships varies: Dec. 15 for the George C. Brooks scholarship (\$7,500 plus 100% nonresident fee waiver equals approx. \$15,838); Stamps Scholars Award (full scholarship) you must be admitted to Mizzou and the Honors College by Dec. 1.**
