**Is the Rep a school Alum?** Did not say **Is the Rep involved in the admissions process?** Yes

**Last year's Freshman Profile:** GPA - 3.75-3.98 SAT – Reading:690-750, Math:700-790 ACT - 31-35

**GPA -How is it calculated?** Core. Unweighted. Only look at Sophomore, Junior and 1st semester Senior year grades.

**ACT/SAT – Written Portion? Super score?** Will superscore the SAT. Will not create a new composite for the ACT.  
**Subject Tests are not required.**

**Rigor - What are the average AP requirements?** Transcript and rigor are very important. Students are expected to take advantage of the strong curriculum at CHS. Up to 12 AP credits can be transferred over to Emory – depending upon the class and if the AP test score is 4 or 5. No AP credit for Human Geography. AP credits will not place students out of any General Education requirements.

**Extra-Curricular Activities –What does the school look for?** Emory wants to see where students made an impact, how much time was dedicated to a club, job, volunteer organization, etc.

**Most popular majors at this school:** Business, Biology, Nursing, Economics, Psychology, Neuroscience & Behavioral Biology, Chemistry, Political Science, Human Health, International Studies. 70+ major and 50+ minors. Do not declare a major until end of sophomore year. Can have 2 majors or 1 major and 1 minor. Nothing beyond 2 items. GaTech and Emory partner with one dual degree in engineering.

**Does chosen major affect decision process?** No. Spend first 2 years at either Emory College or Oxford College (for Freshman and Sophomores only), then either continue at Emory or apply to the business school or the nursing school at Emory.

**Study Abroad Programs?** Study abroad for a semester, summer or year. 100+ programs in 40+ countries.

**Internships / Co-Op Opportunities?** Most students participate in usually more than 1 internship during the course of 4 years. 2,000 in Atlanta and 10,000+ beyond. There are 45K Emory alumni within the perimeter.

**Research Opportunities?** 56% of students work on research with a faculty member.

**Special successes the school is known for:** #20 among national universities (2017 US News & World Report)

**Scholarships:** Scholar Programs: Emory offers partial to full merit scholarships. Emory is an eligible institution for the Georgia Tuition Equalization Grant Program: Recipients receive an award of \$317/quarter or \$475/semester and can receive payment for up to 4 quarters or 3 semesters/year. (Budgeted each year by the Georgia Legislature. The amount of the award may change during the award year.) EMORY MERIT DUE NOVEMBER 15. SELF NOMINATION.

**When are scholarship deadlines?** Nov. 15, however, students applying Early Decision I must apply by Nov. 1.
