**Test optional school- admissions looks at GPA, essay and resume. They have a holistic review which includes an interview as well as graded writing sample.**

**ACT/SAT – Written Portion? Super score? SAT is superscored but not ACT**

**Rigor - What are the average AP requirements? To receive credit for a class, scores are mostly 4-5's. There is more information on the website. Admissions is looking for students that take 5-6 AP's. Since Cambridge offers many, they are looking at students that are challenging themselves academically.**

**Extra-Curricular Activities – What does the school look for? Volunteering, social justice and multicultural organizations. They look for leaderships in clubs and global learning experiences.**
