

Street Challenge Information

Competitive Sports Teams

1. Each competitive sport team consists of number of players + 1 reserve.
 - a. Basketball – 3 players + 1 reserve
 - b. Captain's Ball – 5 players + 1 reserve
 - c. Dodge Ball – 4 players + 1 reserve
 - d. Soccer – 5 players + 1 reserve
2. Teams may sign up without a reserve, however during game play, they will not be allowed to ask anybody outside their team to substitute. If in the event they have not enough players, game play will continue with the number of players left.
3. Members may ask the referee for substitute anytime during the game.
4. Teams have to be mixed gender. (i.e. at least one of the opposite gender in the team)
5. During game play, teams must have mixed gender on court. If in an event that the team does not have a female during game time, they will have to play one player short.
 - a. For example, for basketball, if there are 3 males and 1 female player in a team. In the event that the female player is unable to play, only 2 males will be allowed to play at a time.
6. Only paid teams will be eligible for the competition.
7. All members (including reserve) will receive a Street Challenge 2017 Jersey. (Sizes as indicated upon registration and cannot be changed)
8. All members (including reserve) of the winning teams will receive a prize.
9. Players who are below the age of 21 years (as of 1st September 2017) will have to have an indemnity form signed by his/her parent/guardian. The form is available **here (insert link there)**. Please ensure signed form is handed over to the youth office (3rd floor of The Fireplace, Church of St. Anthony), or on that day itself at the registration booth. Players under the age of 21 years will not be allowed to play if the indemnity form is not signed and passed to the organizers.
10. Teams will be given a large trash bag to keep your bags inside if you'd like to. Please note that bags will not be looked after by the organizers. We are not liable for any loss of personal items or theft.

Family Teams

1. Family teams who have paid for their registration will be able to participate in the games

2. Teams have to make their payment before the 27th of August 2017
3. Families will receive a food and drink coupon for each member registered, it is redeemable at any time during the even as long as there are available food and drinks.

Rules and Regulations

Street Challenge is organized by the Youth of Saint Anthony for the fellowship and community of the Parish of St. Anthony. As such, it is a family oriented event in as much as it is a friendly competition. Please note that vulgarities and abuse (whether physical or verbal) will not be tolerated. The organizers have the right to ask individuals to leave the compound according to their discretion.

Our game officials, time keepers, score keepers, first aiders and all on duty are parishioners and volunteers who are giving their time to allow a fun filled day for our parish. Please do not argue with them or threaten them in any way. If there is a discrepancy in the games, please bring it up to the game head which will be pointed out on that day.

Safety is a major priority during the Street Challenge.

Please look out for our safety officers who will be marked out. There will be a first aid area for all injuries, please approach them if you are feeling unwell. Please play in a safe manner and respectful manner. Any violence of any sort will not be tolerated and offenders will be asked to leave the compound.
