Agri-IPC

Substance: Yellowish liquid containing 400g/litre chlorpropham in the form of an emulsifiable concentrate (CAS No. 101-21-3). Also contains 511g/litre of hydrocarbon liquids (CAS 64742-95-6)

Proper shipping name: FLAMMABLE LIQUID, N.O.S. (Contains 40% chlorpropham)

EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

24 HOUR ADVICE IN AN EMERGENCY ONLY: 0800 243 622

IF THIS HAPPENS	DO THIS
Tanker/Vehicle Accident	Switch off engine and electrical equipment. Keep people away, warn other traffic. Check for spills, leaks. Call the emergency services: Dial 111
Spill or leak	Keep all bystanders away. Wear goggles, respirator, full length chemical resistant overalls (buttoned to neck and wrist), gloves and boots. Sweep up spilled material with inert material and place in sealable container for disposal. Wash down affected area with water plus detergent. Large spills/leaks: Call emergency services 0800 CHEMCALL (0800 243 622). Seek advice from local authority regarding disposal.
Fire	Call the Fire Service: Dial 111. Wear PVC protective clothing and breathing apparatus. Extinguish fires with foam, dry chemical or CO ₂ . During a fire toxic fumes may be released. Contain run-off. Keep non-involved persons away.

FIRST AID

If Swallowed	DO NOT induce vomiting. For advice contact the National Poisons Centre 0800 POISON (0800 764 766) or a doctor immediately. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.
If in Eyes	Hold eyelids apart and flush the eye continuously with running water for at least 15 minutes. Get medical attention.
If on Skin	If skin or hair contact occurs, remove contaminated clothing and flush skin and hair with running water and soap. Wash clothing before reuse. Destroy contaminated shoes and other contaminated leather articles such as belts and watchbands.
If Inhaled	Remove patient to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-nose. Get medical attention if symptoms develop.

STORAGE AND SEGREGATION SUMMARY

Storage: Store in original container in a cool, dry, ventilated place away from direct heat or direct sunlight. Store away from foodstuffs, animal feed, children and animals. Keep container sealed when not in use.

Aggregate Storage Volume Thresholds: When stored with substances of the same hazard the aggregate quantity must be considered. For full details refer to the current NZS8409 Management of Agrichemicals and the HSNO Regulations.

Segregate From: Class 4.2 Spontaneously Combustible, Class 4.3 Dangerous When Wet, Class 5.1 Oxidizing Agent, Class 5.2 Organic Peroxide Foodstuffs or Food Containers.

Segregation: Check the Land Transport Rule Dangerous Goods 2005, Rule 45001/1 for additional information. Sea transport may require additional segregation. Refer NZS5433, sea segregation, for details.
