Scripture directs that when two walk together they must be in agreement so that unity prevails (Amos 3.3). In order for the programs, policies and vision of GCS to be successful, the support and commitment of the parents is vital. Therefore, as a precondition to a student's acceptance, GCS requires that the parent(s) or guardian(s) agree to specific provisions. Your signature on this contract acknowledges your agreement and commitment to these provisions.

I understand that attendance in GCS is a privilege and not a right. Therefore, I agree to the following provisions:

I. In order to support the school with my involvement I purpose by the grace of God to do my best to do the following:

- I will attend the school's Open House, Parent-Teacher Conferences, Student Award Presentation(s), and any other general functions.
- I will build strong parent-teacher relationships. I will review and sign my child's homework assignments, as well as any other notices that are sent home.
- I will make sure my child is at school daily and on time. I will call or send the necessary written excuses for absences or tardies according to the stated school policy.
- I will train my child to respect school property and school authority.

II. Support the school's financial policy in the following ways:

- Pay my financial obligation to GCS according to the guidelines set forth under *Finances in the GCS Student-Parent Handbook*. I understand that a fee will be assessed when my account is paid late. **Tuition:** Since GCS has an obligation to its employees, students are considered enrolled for the entire school year. Tuition is calculated on the basis of the entire year; therefore no reductions can be made for vacations or school holidays. If a student enters after the school year has begun, then charges are prorated according to the actual number of days enrolled. No deductions will be made for tuition during the school year, regardless of the cause of such absence. All accounts must be paid in full for the current term before report cards or transcripts will be issued.
- I agree that should I choose to withdraw my child, whether before the school year begins or during the year, I will make an appointment with the proper school official to discuss the reasons for withdrawal during the exit interview process and agree to sign the necessary forms. I understand that if I withdraw my child after the first of the month, I will remain responsible for the entire month's tuition. I also understand that my child's scholastic records will not be transferred until the exit interview process is completed, the necessary forms are signed and all outstanding fees are paid. I also understand that GCS reserves the right to withdraw my child at the discretion of the administration of GCS as outlined in the *GCS Student-Parent Handbook*.

III. Support the standards, guidelines, policies and vision of the school. I pledge to accomplish this in the following ways:

- I will accept all the rules and guidelines of the school on my child's behalf. I give my permission for the teachers, coaches, principals, superintendent, and pastor of Gateway Church International, to make and enforce classroom/school regulations.
- I accept the Standardized Dress Code of GCS as is set forth in the *GCS Student-Parent Handbook*, and agree to have my student(s) dress according to these published guidelines.
- I understand that should I have a grievance against any teachers, coaches, principals, superintendent, and/or any other individual associated with either GCS or Gateway Church International, I will follow the order of confrontation outlined in the Scriptures (Matthew 18:15-20). I will agreed to follow the *Grievance Policy as is set forth in the GCS Student-Parent Handbook*.
- I understand that students occasionally misrepresent or criticize school situations at home. I pledge that, should that occur, I will not support the criticism, but will communicate with the school personnel involved.
- I understand that in order for my child to be trained properly, I must be willing to cooperate with and adhere to all the *Policies and Procedures set forth in the GCS Student-Parent Handbook*. I have read, understand and agree to adhere to these published school policies and handbook. (Copies available at the Central Office)

IV. Discipline Release

We are honored to partner with you in the training and education of your child. The goal of GCS is not to reform but to teach and train students in a well-disciplined environment. Our heart is to foster both spiritual and academic growth. Attendance at GCS is a privilege and not a right. Therefore, when warranted, discipline will be administered under the following scriptural guidelines:

1. The offense will be clearly discussed.
2. A staff member will discuss scriptural applications.
3. A reasonable number of firm strokes, not to exceed 3, will be administered using a simple flat paddle.
4. A staff witness will be present.
5. Your child will not be physically restrained.
6. After administering the strokes, the staff member will pray with your child, assuring him/her of our love.
7. If your child refuses to submit to paddling, you will be asked to meet to discuss the matter with the school administration.

I believe that discipline is necessary for the welfare of my child, as well as for the entire student body and is consistent with Biblical principles. This may include such measures as instruction, exhortation, correction, rebuke, paddling and other disciplinary actions (i.e. detention, suspension). In accordance with this policy I agree to support the school in its discipline policy without reservation and personally pledge my support of this scriptural approach.
