

After October 5th (up to day of show), entries will be accepted with a \$10 flat surcharge per dog if room is available This trial is limited to 200 runs per day

DAILY FEES AND PACKAGE RATES TRIAL

All runs \$11 per run; every 12th (non-JH) run is free. Your total number of runs can be a combination of all dogs within your household. Junior Handler \$5 per run. Junior Handler (3 day) Package \$35.

CHECK-IN

IF you include a readable photocopy of your dog's NADAC card (for max height dogs) OR Permanent Jump Height Card, with your entry; you will be automatically checked in. This does **NOT** apply to dogs who need to be measured.

Dogs who require measuring must check in and be measured. <u>Measuring is not optional</u>, if a dog is not measured, it is not eligible to run; don't miss your check-in/measure-in time

Times here are tentative, if there are changes, they will be on your confirmation Check-in and measure each day will be 5 to 5:15PM.
Walk through and briefing 5:15 first dog on the line 5:30 PM

Important: During the trial please validate your dog's NADAC registration number on the posted copy of the results at the trial. Report any discrepancies to the trial secretary. **It is the responsibility of each exhibitor to verify their NADAC registration number.**



TENTATIVE RUNNING ORDER

Elite/Elite, Open/Open, Novice/Novice, Intro/Intro

- Running order is determined alphabetically. Handlers with more than one dog in a class will be separated if possible.
- All exhibitors for a given class should be present at ringside at least one-half hour prior to the start of the scheduled classes for walk through and briefing.
- Any dog and handler not present when called will be ineligible to run.

Friday – SMALL TO TALL – 2 rounds of Jumpers, 2 rounds of Regular Saturday - TALL TO SMALL – 2 rounds of Regular, 2 rounds of Chances Sunday - SMALL TO TALL – 2 rounds of Tunnelers, 2 rounds of Weavers (Subject to Change as Necessary)

"Welcome to NADAC" Rate

If you have never done NADAC before, or it's been over 3 years since you have done NADAC, we are offering a welcome to the venue deal where you can enter all classes each day for 50% OFF your entry. It is only valid for your first time at a NADAC trial as the handler or those that haven't done NADAC in over 3 years. New dogs under a handler who has done NADAC before are not eligible.

EMAIL ENTRY POLICY

Jumping Chollas is currently accepting entries by email with the following conditions:

- Email entries that are received after the closing date are considered late entries and the late fee will be charged
- Payment must be made <u>SIMULTANEOUSLY</u> using PAYPAL Friends and Family to whultsma@asu.edu
- Withdrawing from the show after the closing date or failure to attend the show without
 withdrawing DOES NOT EXCUSE YOU FROM PAYING. The club has expenses for every dog
 entered by the trial secretary and every run that is on the books at the start of the show.
- No coupons can be used with email entries
- Failure to pay required fees will exclude the exhibitor from future Jumping Chollas shows.

REFUNDS

There will be no refunds for entries withdrawn after the closing date or in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of the reason for such dismissal.

A withdrawal from the competition after the closing date due, before the show to a bitch coming into season after the closing date will be eligible for a refund up to 75% of the total entry fee paid.

No entry fee refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire an act of God, public emergency and act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

MOVE-UPS

Move-ups, changes, or corrections will accept in writing only (or e-mail to whultsma@asu.edu) through October 8th at 6:00PM. No changes/corrections will be accepted after this date. This includes any changes that need to be made because of incorrect entry on trial secretary's part. Anyone with day of show corrections will have a \$10 fee charged for all changes that were not the trail secretary's part. Please read your confirmations carefully!!!! There are no move ups from round 1 to round 2 on the same day. There are move ups from Friday to Saturday.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Exhibitors through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of NADAC rules and regulations and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of the trial.

- Dogs must have valid NADAC registration numbers before entries will be accepted. The application for a NADAC registration number is available at www.nadac.com.
- Please double-check your entry form to ensure it is filled out completely and correctly. Entry may be returned if missing
 information is critical to entry. Example, if Skilled or Proficient is not circled or if the jump height is not listed or no NADAC #.
- We will provide electronic confirmations to all entrants who include their email addresses with their entry. If you included and
 email address, your conformation will be sent as an attachment (PDF) in an email. It is your responsibility to make sure
 whultsma@asu.edu is allowed by your spam blocker or to change options that strip attachment from emails.

- Confirmation of entry will be sent to the address provided on the entry form (e-mail or snail mail) after closing date. If an exhibitor has not received a copy of the confirmation within 7 days of the closing date, contact the Trial Secretary
- Checks not honored by the bank DO NOT constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$35 service charge for bank returned checks.
- All dogs must be on leash when not competing in the ring.
- · No Alcoholic Beverages allowed on the show site.
- Ribbons/Coupons will be awarded to first through fourth places in all jump heights except for Chances. Since Chances is a
 pass/fail game, placements are not given. Ribbons/Coupons awarded for those finishing a title and qualifying
 Ribbons/Coupons awarded for those achieving a qualifying score.
- The sponsoring club will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor whether the result is accident or other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of fees paid will be made
- Rubberized surfaces are used on all contact obstacles. Weave poles have 24" spacing. No water and only very limited shade is available at the site please bring sufficient water for you and your dog(s).

IMPORTANT. Please check your dog's NADAC registration number on your trial confirmation as soon as you receive it; also, please check the copy of the results posted at the trial. You should report any errors to the Trial Secretary immediately.

NADAC records trial results as they are submitted by the host clubs/groups. The individual trial results submitted by the club are uploaded to the www.NADACForum.com within two weeks after the NADAC office receives them from the club. Please accept the responsibility to review those results, and check that your registration number and qualifying points, as reported by the club, are correct. You can join the Forum by going to www.NADACForum.com and submitting your request. If you find an error in the reporting of your dog's qualifying points or registration number, please contact the host club. The host club is responsible for correcting any errors and informing NADAC.

Levels. Points earned at a higher level of a class, prior to the completion of the lower level title, will not be recorded by NADAC for future use. If a dog earns points in a level of a class that they are not eligible to title in, those points will not be added to the dog's records.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Below is a brief summary of NADAC rules. Please refer to <u>www.nadac.com</u> for a full explanation of all NADAC rules and up to date information.

Please note that NADAC trials should provide a safe and fun environment for both exhibitors and their dogs.

Aggressive dogs will not be tolerated and will be excused from the trial.

The show committee has the right to refuse any entry. Anyone not currently in good standing with NADAC will not be allowed to enter this trial.

Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of NADAC rules and regulations, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial.

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Checks not honored by the bank do not constitute a valid entry fee. There be a \$35.00 service charge for bank returned checks.

PROFICIENT / SKILLED CATEGORIES:

Each class will be split into two categories, Proficient and Skilled.

Skilled Category, dogs jump 4" lower than indicated by the current jump height table. (No dog can jump less than 4").

Dogs entered in the either category may incur 5 or fewer faults, (course/time) and earn a 5 pt. qualifying round in Regular agility.

NON-JUMPING CLASSES - VETERAN OR DISABLED HANDLER

Handlers who are 60 years or older, or who have a disability that restricts mobility, may choose to enter the non-jumping classes as a Veteran Handler and receive 10% more standard course time. This option is for Veteran/Disabled handlers in the non-jumping classes only.

The Veteran/Disabled Handler division is designed for handlers who, due to age or impairment, are mobility limited and need extra time to guide their canine partners through an agility course.

When entering as a Veteran/Disabled Handler, you must enter all dogs in all classes for the entire trial in this Division and must jump 4" lower than your Proficient, Standard Division jump height requires. In the non-jumping classes, dogs will be scored and placed with their Standard Division jump height

Jump Heights

Dogs entered in the Proficient Category must jump at the minimum jump height specified by the following table. Dogs entering the Skilled Category MUST jump one jump height lower than the heights listed in the table, although no dog shall jump lower than 4". All dogs must jump their valid jump height as determined by their Category and Division and may not jump higher.

As the table shows, there are four Standard Division-Proficient jump heights: 8", 12", 16", 20", There are four Standard Division-Skilled jump heights: 4", 8", 12", and 16". There are four jump heights for the Veterans and Junior Handler divisions: 4", 8", 12", and 16".

Veterans and Junior Handler dogs must jump their valid jump height and may not jump higher; thus, a Vets or JH dog may not jump higher than 16" in the Proficient category and no higher than 12" in the Skilled category.

There is no 4" Standard Division jump height in Proficient; the 4" Proficient height is for veteran dogs/handlers, disabled handlers, and junior handlers only. In the Skilled category, 8" dogs may jump 4" as their standard jump height. No dog may jump lower than 4"

DIRECTIONS TO FACILITY: Take Happy Valley Rd., to 15th Ave, turn North to the second lot on your left, which is enclosed by a block wall. Park in the lot as closely as possible to the other vehicles. YOU MAY PARK ALONG THE NORTH WALL OUTSIDE OF THE FACILITY. NO PARKING IS PERMITTED ALONG 15TH AVE. NOTE THAT CARPOOLING MAY BE NECESSARY!

From Phoenix (or Flagstaff) - Take I-17 North (or South) to Happy Valley Rd. Go east.

This event will be held outdoors on artificial turf under the lights.

There will not be a food vendor on site. Bring water for your dogs.

OVERNIGHT RV PARKING

No RV parking is available on site. You may park an RV without hookups at the Cracker Barrel at I-17 and Deer Valley Road, or you may contact Billie Rosen about parking on her property - AGILEK9S@PHOPAWS.ORG

This event will be held outdoors on artificial turf surface with no shade or water. You will need to provide shade and water for your dog(s). Note that NOTHING can be staked on the turf!

AGREEMENT

The person who signs this agreement represents that he/she is authorized to enter into this agreement on behalf of both exhibitor and the owner of entered dog. In consideration of acceptance of this entry:

- 1. As used here "NADAC" means the North American Dog Agility Council, LLC., and their members, officers, directors, employees, show chairs, show committees and agents.
- 2. Exhibitor/owner agrees to abide by the rules and regulations of NADAC and any other rules and regulations appearing in the premium for this event.
- 3. Exhibitor/owner certifies that the entered dog is not a hazard to persons, dogs or property and that the entered dog's rabies vaccination is current in accordance with the requirement of the state in which the dog resides.
- 4. Exhibitor/owner acknowledge all hazards presented by the event and the event premises, including, but not limited to, the condition of the floors, stairways, halls, lighting, security measures or lack of, electrical appliances, fittings, show rings, parking areas and the presence of unfamiliar animals and people; exhibitor and owner assume the risk of any harm arising from these.
- 5. Exhibitor/owner release NADAC, (including their officers, directors, employees, and members), Jumping Chollas Agility Club (including its officers, agents, and employees), and will defend them and hold them harmless from all present and future loss, injury, damage, claims, demands and liabilities involving the entered dog, the event or event premises. Exhibitor/owner hereby assume sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the afore-mentioned parties for damages because of bodily injuries, including death, at any time in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, howsoever such injury, or death may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may have been alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents or any other persons.
