## **Crating available:**

Lots of space for crating, no shade. NO STAKING ON THE TURF! Parking is limited at this site.

## **Entry Limits:**

This trial is limited to 300 runs per day.

#### Move ups:

Move-ups, changes, or corrections will be accepted by e-mail to <a href="mailto:agility\_pups@cox.net">agility\_pups@cox.net</a> through June 3 at 5:00 PM. Please read your confirmations carefully by June 3. There will be no move-ups between days of the show.

## Day of Show/Late Entries:

Late entries (after May 30) will be accepted with a \$10 flat surcharge per dog if room is available, day of show entries accepted until the course in question is built and numbered

#### Refunds:

There will be no refunds for entries withdrawn after the closing date or in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of the reason for such dismissal.

A withdrawal from the competition after the closing date due to a bitch coming into season after the closing date will be eligible for a refund up to 75% of the total entry fee paid.

No entry fee refunded if the trial cannot open or completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire an act of God, public emergency and act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

## **Awards and Ribbons:**

Ribbons/Coupons will be awarded to first through fourth places in all jump heights except for Chances. Since Chances is a pass/fail game, placements are not given. Ribbons/Coupons awarded for those finishing a title and qualifying Ribbons/Coupons awarded for those achieving a qualifying score.

Please let the Show Chair and Show Secretary know if your dog may earn a NATCH or V-NATCH at this show.

Dogs listed on the Height Exemption List

#### **JUMP HEIGHTS**

There are four Standard Division-Proficient jump heights: 8", 12", 16", and 20".

There are four Standard Division-Skilled jump heights: 4", 8", 12", and 16".

There are four jump heights for the Veterans and Junior Handler divisions: 4", 8", 12", and 16".

## **Brief Summary of Rules:**

Please refer to <a href="https://www.nadac.com">www.nadac.com</a> for a full explanation of all NADAC rules and up to date information.

- Please note that NADAC trials should provide a safe and fun environment for both exhibitors and their dogs.
- Aggressive dogs will not be tolerated and will be excused from the trial.
- The show committee has the right to refuse any entry. Anyone not currently in good standing with NADAC will not be allowed to enter this trial.
- Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of NADAC rules and regulations, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil
  disturbances, fire, acts of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause
  beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Checks not honored by the bank do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$25.00 service charge for bank returned checks.
- Dog must be registered and have a valid registration number before entries will be accepted. <a href="http://nadac.com/afrm/dogregfrm.asp">http://nadac.com/afrm/dogregfrm.asp</a> A copy of the current Exhibitors Handbook may be downloaded free from the NADAC web site: www.nadac.com
- Bitches in heat, lame, or blind dogs are ineligible for entry, as is any dog with a deformity which
  may cause a judge to not be able to reasonably assess the dog's ability to function and
  perform agility obstacles safely, and in a manner that is in the best interest, health and welfare
  of the dog.
- No food, clickers, or other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course or within 10 feet of the ring. Food or a small non-audible toy can be in a secure container (ziplock bag is acceptable) in your pocket during your run but it cannot be used during your run, nor can you indicate to the dog it is there. Only Intro and Novice handlers may bring a non-audible toy into the ring for training purposes. They cannot earn a Qualifying score and must declare to the judge they are training before they commence their run. Please read the Exhibitor's Handbook for more information about toys and training in the ring.
- The sponsoring clubs will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for
  the possessions of any exhibitor whether the result be accident or other cause. It is distinctly
  understood that every dog at this event is in the care and control of his owner or handler during
  the entire time the dog is on the show premises.

#### **AGREEMENT**

The person who signs this agreement represents that he/she is authorized to enter into this agreement on behalf of both exhibitor and the owner of entered dog. In consideration of acceptance of this entry:

- 1.1. As used here "NADAC" means the North American Dog Agility Council, LLC., its members, officers, directors, employees, show chairs, show committees and agents.
- 1.2. Exhibitor/owner agree to abide by the rules and regulations of NADAC and any other rules and regulations appearing in the premium for this event.
- 1.3. Exhibitor/owner certify that the entered dog is not a hazard to persons, dogs or property and that the entered dog's rabies vaccination is current in accordance with the requirement of the state in which the dog resides
- 1.4. Exhibitor/owner acknowledge all hazards presented by the event and the event premises, including, but not limited to, the condition of the surface, restrooms, security measures or lack of, electrical appliances, fittings, show rings, parking areas and the presence of unfamiliar animals and people; exhibitor and owner assume the risk of any harm arising from these.
- 1.5. Exhibitor/owner releases NADAC (including its respective officers, directors, employees, and members), Jumping Chollas Agility Club (including its officers, directors, members, and event organizing committee), and Jefferson County Fairgrounds (including its officers, agents, and employees) and will defend them and hold them harmless from all present and future loss, injury, damage, claims, demands and liabilities involving the entered dog, the event or event premises. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing hold harmless provisions, exhibitor/owner hereby specifically assumes sole responsibility for and agrees to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damages because of bodily injuries, including death, at any time in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, howsoever such injury or death may be caused and whether or not the same may have been caused or may have been alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents or any other persons

#### **Run Pricing info**

All classes for adult handlers \$12/run. Each 12th adult run from a single household is free.

Junior Handlers - \$6 per run

Late fee \$10 per dog if received after April 10

If you have never done NADAC before, or its been over 3 years since you have done NADAC, we are offering a welcome to the venue deal where you can enter all classes each day for 50% OFF your entry. It is only valid for your first time at a NADAC trial as the handler or those that haven't done NADAC in over 3 years. New dogs under a handler who has done NADAC before are not eligible.

#### Jumping Chollas is currently accepting entries by email with the following conditions:

- Email entries that are received after the closing date are considered late entries and the late fee will be charged
- Payment must be made promptly. Withdrawing from the show after the closing date or failure to attend
  the show without withdrawing DOES NOT EXCUSE YOU FROM PAYING. The club has expenses for every
  dog entered by the trial secretary and every run that is on the books at the start of the show.

Failure to pay required fees will exclude the exhibitor from future Jumping Chollas shows.



This event will be held outdoors on artificial turf surface with **no** shade or water. You will need to provide shade and water for your dog(s). Note that NOTHING can be staked on the turf!

25128 N. 15th Ave., Phoenix. From Happy Valley Rd. turn north onto 15th Ave., which is a dirt road. Please drive slowly and park *inside* the block walled area at the Cholla Patch, or you may park along the NORTH wall outside of the facility. No parking is permitted along 15th Ave. Note that carpooling may be necessary!
