Veterans Benefits – This training will educate community providers about general eligibility for VA healthcare and services. Attendees will learn about the three branches of the federal Veterans Administration, the process of enrolling in VA healthcare, costs of outpatient care at VA, and various services and benefits that may be available to Veterans and their families.
