### **Incident Management and Lessons Learned — Las Vegas Shooting Incident**

Timothy Orenic, BS

EMS Field Coordinator, Las Vegas Fire & Rescue, USA

Approaching 30 years in the field, Timothy Orenic has worked his way up from a volunteer firefighter and paramedic in Illinois to his current position as EMS Field Coordinator in Las Vegas, USA. In his present role, Mr. Orenic has multiple responsibilities, including overseeing the daily operational activities at the EMS agency, Incident Commander for complex EMS operations, and EMS trainer. In this session, Mr. Orenic will share how Las Vegas Fire & Rescue swiftly handled and managed the EMS duties during the recent Las Vegas shooting incident, as well as lessons learned from it.

David has an extensive background in EMS and has held many concurrent positions throughout his career. Prior to this, David held a number of positions at Standards New Zealand, including Standards Development Consultant — Health, Safety and Environment, Senior Project Manager — Health, Safety and Environment, and also General Manager — Standards and Development.

### **EMS Peer Review: How We Do It, Protect It, and Drive Innovation**

Deputy Chief Medical Officer, St. Charles County Ambulance District, USA

John Romeo has been working in the EMS field for the past 18 years. Starting off as a Paramedic at the North Jefferson County Ambulance District, Mr. Romeo is now Deputy Chief Medical Officer at St. Charles County Ambulance District (SCCAD). He is responsible for developing protocols, clinical care, and managing QA/QI programs. SCCAD is one of the few agencies in Missouri with an active peer review process, which is designed to improve care quality and patient safety by learning from past performances, errors, and near misses. Mr. Romeo will walk you through the paramedic peer-to-peer review process at SCCAD and show how it helped them reach their ultimate goal of delivering the right care at the right time to improve patient outcomes.
