SEND REVIEW

Session purpose

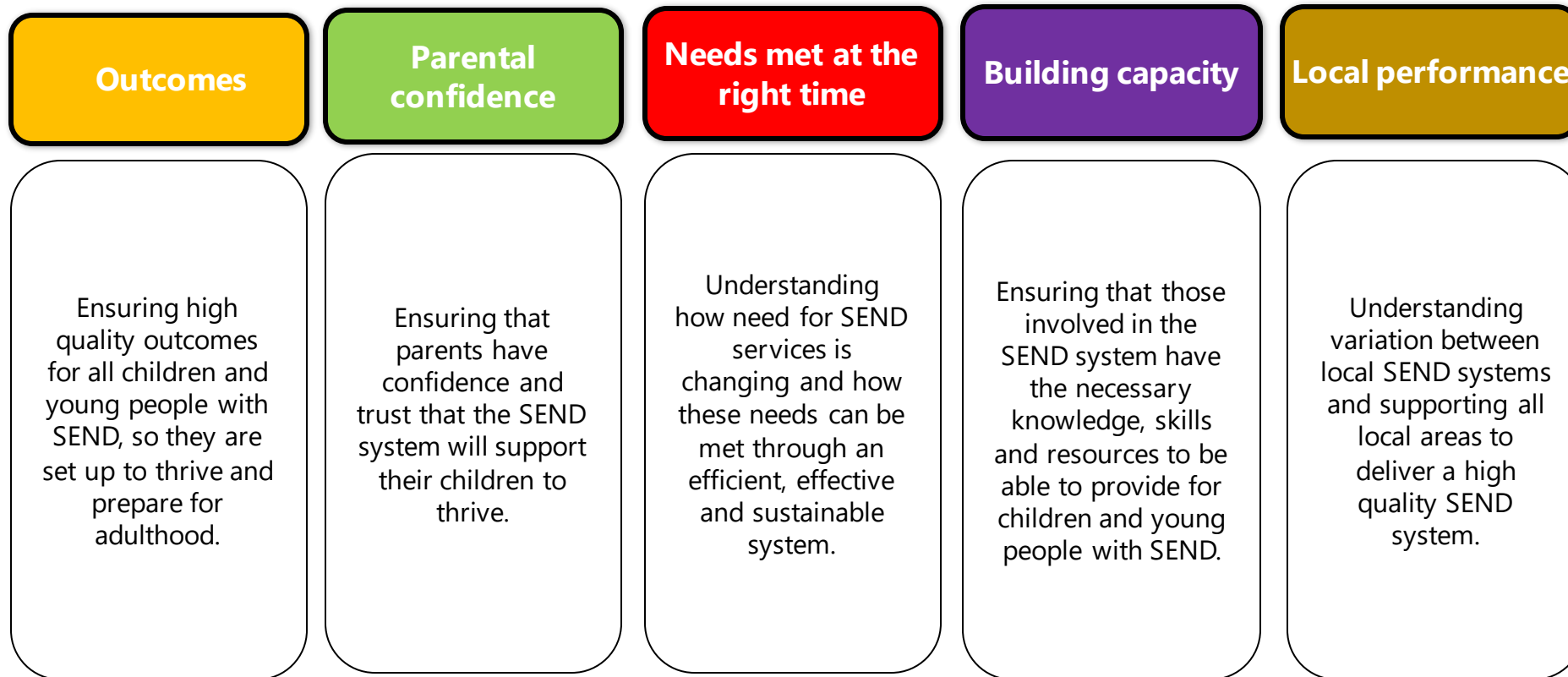
In September 2019, the Department for Education announced a review of the SEND system.

The review will consider two key questions:

1. To what extent is the current system efficient and effective in providing the right support to children and young people with SEND so that they thrive and are prepared for adulthood?
 2. What additional changes might be needed to improve the efficiency, effectiveness and sustainability of the system, with a focus on the needs of the individual and how could these be achieved now and in the future?
- The review is due to report next year.
 - DfE officials are unable to present today or facilitate these discussions due to the restrictions on civil servants during the pre-election period, however DfE officials are here today to listen to discussions and your written feedback will be taken back to the Department and fed into the review.

What is the SEND Review doing?

Asking: can we ensure that the SEND system is efficient and effective in providing the right support for children and young people with SEND so that they thrive and are prepared for adulthood?



Your task, your role, 7 themes

This is your opportunity to discuss a number of important questions that will be of relevance to the review.

On each table there are sheets of paper with a number of themes and questions to prompt discussion.

Tables should choose two or three themes to discuss and record their thoughts beneath the prompt questions.
