Description

Oxford is a top-yielding feed barley with broad adaptability & excellent resistance to lodging. It is a short-stawed, medium-long season variety that is photoperiod sensitive; remaining in a vegative state during the peak frost periods, while responding to increasing day length in late September / early October. It responds well to early planting and is suitable for main season planting.
