# Here are a few things you should know about this production:

- Age range: 9-20 years old. Children aged 6-8 with prior stage experience may audition, however, the director reserves the right to refuse to cast based on his or her evaluation of the child's readiness. Note: Auditionees of the advertised age range will be considered first for casting all open roles. However, in the event that a role cannot be cast appropriately by the available pool of auditionees of the advertised age, CMT and the Director reserves the right to invite cast members from the community who are not within the advertised age range.
- Auditions for Frozen Jr. are October 5 and 6 at 1:00 pm sharp at our space in Sierra Vista Mall.
   Choose a day and doors will be open at 3:30pm. Plan to arrive with all paperwork filled out
   and your \$25 processing fee. Tuition is \$250 and can be paid at the time of audition. Please
   have 16 32 bars of a song memorized and bring sheet music (no auditions can be acapella).
   An accompanist will be provided.
- CALLBACKS will be Monday, October 7th at 6:00pm. If you are unable to attend callbacks please let us know at the time you audition and other arrangements can be made. Auditions, callbacks, and rehearsals are at Sierra Vista Mall (at the CMT rehearsal space next to Gold Coast Gallery, see audition section of website for directions).
- The Cast list will be posted by the Thursday after auditions. Rehearsals begin October 21st and will be Monday-Friday from 6-9pm. Specific information about any rehearsal time or site changes will be given when known. Some ensemble performers/kids will not need to be at all rehearsals. The weekly schedule will be determined when rehearsals start. The director will make every effort to limit rehearsals for younger cast when they are not needed.
- Performances will be December 6th-15th. School shows will be Friday mornings December 6th, Thursday and Friday Mornings Dec 12th and 13th. Weds the 11th could be added.
- All conflicts should be on calendar at time of auditions. If new conflicts come up after auditions you have until the first day of rehearsal to notify CMT. Conflicts requested after that date will be considered, but could have an impact on being able to continue in the production. If you wish to change your current appearance (e.g. hair color, length, etc.) after casting please consult with the director first.
- All performances will take place at the Fresno Memorial Auditorium in downtown Fresno.

# Character Breakdown

**Young Anna** - Princess of Arendelle at her youngest. Adventurous & loyal, loves her sister.

**Middle Anna** - Anna is older & grappling with the change in her relationship with Elsa.

Adult Anna - Secluded from the world, adult Anna longs for connection & misses her sister.

**Young Elsa -** Next in line for the throne, Elsa has been born with magical powers that can overwhelm her when she becomes afraid & harm others if not handled with care.

**Middle Elsa** - Elsa becomes anxious & withdrawn as she grows older, before eventually learning to take control of, & become confident in, her powers.

Adult Elsa - Ruler of Arendelle. Very strong singer who can portray Elsa's restrained nature.

**King Agnarr** - The warm-hearted ruler of Arendelle is committed to protecting both his family & the Townspeople from his eldest daughter's powers.

**Queen Iduna** - The queen possesses a sense of rightness & kindness that guides her in her protection of her two young girls.

Pabbie - Pabbie & Bulda are the mystical leaders of the Hidden Folk who have a soft spot for "strays."

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**Bishop** - The bishop officiates the coronation & passing of the crown to Elsa.

**Kristoff** - Kristoff has a sarcastic veneer & a rough-around-the-edges exterior that hides a big heart. Anna's love interest.

**Sven** - Sven is a reindeer of few words, fiercely loyal pal to Kristoff, & loves giving the ice harvester a hard time.

Hans - The ambitious Prince of the Southern Isles, Elsa's love interest turned villain!

Weselton - A visiting duke who possesses a huge inferiority complex. Comedic relief!

**Olaf** - The magical snowman created by Anna & Elsa when they were young.

Oaken - An exceedingly cheerful wandering salesperson; leads the song "Hygge"

#### **AGE POLICY**

Auditionees must be of the advertised age by audition weekend for any production. CMT reserves the right to request proof of age at any time. Note: Auditionees of the advertised age range will be considered first for casting all open roles. However, in the event that the director and/or vocal coach find that a role cannot be cast appropriately by the available pool of auditionees of the advertised age, CMT and the Director reserves the right to invite cast members from the community who are not within the advertised age range.

## **REFUND POLICY**

Upon notification of casting decisions you are then entitled to a refund if you choose to withdraw from the production within **48 hours** of the cast list being posted, **however the \$25.00 processing fee paid at the time of auditions is non-refundable.** After that you **will not** be entitled to a refund. Withdrawal from a production for reasons other than medical, financial or you have been excused by the Artistic Director for extenuating circumstances; could cause you to not be allowed to audition for the next CMT production for which you are eligible.

## **ATTENDANCE POLICY**

It is expected that this production will be a priority commitment. Each performer is required to attend all his/her scheduled rehearsals. All rehearsal conflicts must be communicated to CMT staff at auditions using the Production Registration form and/or any other forms required by CMT staff. If continued conflicts persist into the rehearsal process, performers may be removed from a production with no refund given. Even if conflicts are reported in advance; please be aware that missing rehearsal may prevent you from being staged into scenes and musical numbers. If this is a problem, we urge that you reconsider auditioning for this production. **Rehearsal schedules are subject to change.** Changes occur to make the most productive use of time and to create the most rewarding results. "Tech Week" is the last week prior to performances and attendance is MANDATORY, **No exceptions**. Rehearsals might run long and possibly late into the evening during the week prior to performances, so please be prepared for this.

#### **SPONSORSHIP PROGRAM**

Students in need of tuition assistance are encouraged to seek sponsorship from local businesses, friends or family. Full tuition sponsors will receive two tickets to the show in which the student performs. Sponsorship forms are available on the website and at auditions. #### **COSTUME POLICY**

CMT will provide costumes for all performers. Each performer will be responsible for providing his or her own shoe wear (if applicable), tights, undergarments and makeup for each production.

#### **VOLUNTEERISM AND GETTING INVOLVED**

Volunteers are a crucial part of our organization. Join **CMT Parent** - applications will be available at auditions. As a family-oriented organization all parents, guardians and family members are encouraged to get involved in the productions of CMT by helping with scenery construction, costume assistance, props, supervision, etc. **LOAD IN AND STRIKE ARE MANDATORY FOR ALL PERFORMERS (OR ONE PARENT IF PERFORMER IS UNDER 16). HOURS AND ASSIGNMENTS WILL BE SCHEDULED PRIOR TO BOTH DATES.** 

## **GENERAL POLICIES**

Notify staff regarding any special circumstances or medical requirements you might have. Parents/Guardians must check for adult supervision before leaving their children at rehearsals. CMT will not assume responsibility for children left unsupervised before posted rehearsal times. Parent/Guardian MUST pick up their child at the designated time and no later. Additional monetary charges, to the parent in question, may result for regular violation of this policy. All rehearsals are open to parents and guardians, until tech week at Fresno Memorial Auditorium. Those rehearsals are closed. Detailed drop off and pick up instructions will be provided prior to tech week. Auditionees must satisfy the tuition requirement before they will be allowed to audition. Auditionees must audition at one of the published audition dates and times. No auditionees will be allowed to audition outside these dates unless prior arrangements have been made with the Directors.
