

Existing rule:

11. DOCK AREA: Boats shall adhere to the follow rules regarding laying alongside the Dock The dock is Color coded as follows: GREEN: overnight with permission of Executive member, YELLOW: while skipper is on Club Premises; do not leave boat unattended, RED: load and unload only. Times and restrictions may be altered at the discretion of the Rear-Commodore and other Flag Officers. Any discharge onto the dock must be cleaned up by the Member.

New rule:

Boats shall adhere to the following rules regarding laying alongside the Dock:

- 1) The concrete dock shall be reserved for larger boats with deep keels.
- 2) Areas marked RED: load and unload only. 15 mins Max.
- 3) Areas marked YELLOW: while skipper is on Club premises; do not leave boat unattended. 3 hour Max.
- 4) Areas marked GREEN: Long Term /Overnight. 12 hour max in 48 hour period. More than 12 hours with permission of Commodore or Rear Commodore, or by recording in Log Book.

Notes:

- Times and restrictions may be altered at the discretion of the Rear Commodore and other Flag officers.
- All Trash/ Boating gear and cleaning effluent discharged onto the dock or in the water must be cleaned up by the Member and their Guests. Use environmentally friendly products for cleaning.
- During Sailing events, Junior Sailing and Fitted Dinghy support boats will have priority at the Dock.
- CCTV cameras are in operation at all times.

***Failure to adhere to these rules will result in Disciplinary Action.

Existing Rule:

16. WATERCRAFT STORAGE: No watercraft of any type will be allowed to be stored on the Club property without registration. A registration form is available from the Bar / Rear Commodore. Upon approval and payment of the annual registration fee, a decal will be issued which must be displayed on the watercraft in the location specified. Watercraft must be stored in specified areas. Non-approval of registration will require immediate removal. Any unregistered watercraft left longer than 90 days on the property will be removed without notification and/or forfeited to the Club. The Club reserves the right to dispose of the watercraft as they see fit. Any expenses incurred by the Club to remove said watercraft will be for the Members account. The annual registration fee for Watercraft will be agreed by the Executive Committee and notice posted accordingly. Annual billing will occur at the same time each year. Only a Member in good standing will be afforded this privilege.

New rule:

16. No Watercraft of any type will be allowed to be stored on the Club property without showing current Marine and Ports Registration. It must also be registered at the Club. A registration form is available from the Bar / Rear Commodore. Upon approval and payment of the annual registration fee, a decal will be issued which must be displayed on the Watercraft in the location specified. Non-approval of registration will

require immediate removal. Any unregistered Watercraft left longer than 90 days on the property will be removed without notification and/or forfeited to the Club. The Club reserves the right to dispose of the watercraft as they see fit. Any expenses incurred by the Club to remove said Watercraft will be for the Member's account.

Watercraft must be stored in specified areas. All Watercraft should be in their reserved spots on the rack, or on the grass. Any punts left off the rack will be removed to the grass.

The annual registration fee for Watercraft will be agreed by the Executive Committee and notice posted accordingly. Watercraft fees are due February 1st. If you no longer wish to store your Watercraft at the Club, please give notice of your intent to remove it. Only a Member in good standing will be afforded this privilege.

Note: Watercraft refers to all types of watercraft, including punts, kayaks and sail boats etc.
